

Griffith High School Boys Golf Contract
2019

1. All players must follow the policies and guidelines set by the IHSAA and Griffith High School. Coach Worosz also reserves the right to dismiss a player from the team.
2. All players must attend all practices for the total duration of the practice. Only school absence and academics can be counted as an excused absence. If you do not attend school, you may not come to practice or meets that day. Each unexcused practice absence will result in a one-match suspension. Missing practice because of a detention is inexcusable.
3. Transportation will be provided to all in season practices and meets. Be on time for departure times. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence. A waiver can be signed to use your own transportation for practices only.
4. On the golf course you are expected to dress accordingly. This means no denim, cutoffs, tank tops, etc. You will be required to wear a collard shirt of modern golf shirt, plus a pair of shorts, slacks, or athletic wear pants and proper footwear. Cold weather gear is acceptable during cold weather. Failure to comply with this rule, will result in not being able to participate for the day, and will be counted as an unexcused absence.
5. Follow all the rules of golf. Intentional cheating will be a cause for denial of privilege to participate for the season. Accidental rules violations will be handled according to the rules of golf. Although golf is a competitive sport, golf is also a test of mental and emotional discipline. A great shot is something to behold and enjoy; a bad shot must be put behind you. Physical expression of temper (throwing clubs, damaging the course, etc.) will not be tolerated and will result in a disciplinary consequence.
6. Come to practice mentally prepared and set out to practice your best. Do not settle for being average. Your attitude is proportional to your level of play in golf.
7. Remember you are expected to conduct yourself in a way that brings credit and respect to your teammates, the program, the sport, and our school. You represent the program whether you are on the golf course, in the classroom, or in the hallways. We expect you to conduct yourself in a positive manner. Above all we are always gentlemen.
8. To earn a varsity letter in golf, you must compete in 50% of the regular season varsity meets and have a meet average under 50. Coach Worosz also reserves the right to letter or not letter any participant.
9. The team will consist of 12-14 players. If cuts are required each player will be evaluated by the coach to determine their ability to make a positive contribution to the golf team.

Signing this contract demonstrates that you understand the 9 points above and agree to them as a participant or as a parent of a participant on the boys golf team.
