EVENT ATTENDANCE PROTOCOLS for SPECTATORS

Beginning August 15th, 2020

We are excited to welcome students, coaches, staff, support personnel, and our fans to Kokomo High School as we begin the 2020 Fall Sports season.

In accordance with guidelines from the CDC, ISDH, IDOE, IHSAA, as well as Governor Eric Holcomb's most recent mandates, Kokomo School Corporation will require ALL spectators to observe the following procedures when attending Athletic events hosted by Kokomo High School.

Our Commitment to Safety:

- Kokomo High School and Kokomo School Corporation have implemented safety procedures to mitigate the potential spread of COVID-19. However, risks remain in attending a school event, including exposure to COVID-19.
- Spectators assume all risks related to exposure of COVID-19.
- Spectators must comply with ALL posted signs and placards, as well as verbal guidance from school officials, while attending school events.

Spectator Capacity: [250 persons per bleacher section]

- Walter Cross Field (Football / Soccer) – 1500
- Haworth Gymnasium (Volleyball) – 500
- Kokomo High School Soccer Fields – 250
- Kokomo High School Tennis Courts – Please maintain social distancing (6 feet) protocols.

Purchasing Tickets:

- Tickets for all events are \$6 (Cash Only) and will be sold at the gate prior to home events, **except football.**
- Football tickets are **available for presale**. For each event, tickets are available on a first come, first serve basis until all tickets have been distributed. All Sports Pass holders must present your card at the time of pick-up. Each participating school will be provided a limited number of tickets available for pre-sale.
- At Kokomo High School advanced football tickets can be purchased the week of a game, using the following schedule:

- **Monday** – All Sports Pass holders may come to pick up their tickets. You may pick up all football home game tickets at this time. No one can enter an event without a paper ticket.
- **Tuesday** – Ticket sales for parents of football/cheerleader/band students (4 ticket limit per participant)
- **Wednesday/Thursday** – General admission ticket sales.
- **Friday** – General admission ticket sales end at 1:00 p.m.
- **Friday** – Will be sold at gate beginning one hour before the game, pending availability.

Students/Staff may purchase/pick-up tickets in the Athletic Office from 7am-2:30pm.

By Appointment ONLY: All other patrons must call the Athletic Office at 765-455-8053 to schedule a time to purchase/pick up tickets between the hours of 7am-2:30pm.

Facial Coverings: **per Gov. Eric Holcomb's Executive Order (7/22/2020)*

- Facial coverings required at all times for spectators ages 8 and above for indoor events.
- Facial coverings required at all times for spectators ages 8 and above for outdoor events when social distancing of 6 feet or greater cannot be obtained while seated.

Seating/Viewing Area restrictions

- Please choose a seat that is at least 6 feet away from non-immediate family members.
- While seated, facial coverings may be removed for eating and drinking provided social distancing of 6 feet or greater from non-immediate family members can be obtained.
- If facial coverings are not worn for medical reasons, you must maintain social distancing of 6 feet or greater at all times.

Restroom Usage/Capacity

- Capacity numbers will be placed on each door.
- Masks must be worn for all spectators ages 8 and above at all times while using the restroom.

Concession Stand Service

- When possible, concessions will be available with multiple windows open.
- All concession items will be pre-packaged.
