



Mayfield High School Basketball Regulations

All participants and spectators must conduct a symptom assessment before entering the facility.

All coaches, spectators, event staff, and athletes not actively participating in physical activity must wear a mask/face covering at all times.

Players must have their own water bottles, masks, and towels. No equipment is to be shared. Water jugs with touchless bottle fillers will be provided to both teams.

Teams should come dressed and ready to play. Locker rooms will only be used for restrooms, pregame, and at half time.

Teams waiting for a game to end will sit in the bleachers behind the benches and maintain appropriate physical distancing.

Spectators should only attend the game that their child is participating in. They should not attend earlier games or stay for later games. No spectators will be permitted at scrimmages.

All spectators will sit on the north side of the gymnasium across from their team's bench.

2020 NFHS RULE MODIFICATIONS

Pre-Game Protocol

- Only the referee and the head coach from each team will meet, with each coach standing on the center circle on each side of the division line.
- There will be no team tunnel, nor any shaking of hands or fist bumps during pregame introductions.

Team Benches

- Bench personnel must observe social distancing 6 feet.
- Coaches and athletes in the bench area must wear masks/face coverings at all times.
- Only necessary team personnel should be sitting in the bench area.

Substitution Procedures

- Contact between players should be limited when substituting

Officials Table

- Only the official home and visitor scorers, clock operator, and announcer are permitted at the table.

Post-Game Ceremony

- Post-game handshakes or fist bumps are suspended

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Game balls will be sanitized prior to use and during time outs and between quarters.
- A separate rack of warmup balls will be used during the pregame and halftime warmup period.
- Sanitizer will be available at the scorer's table and in both bench areas.

Recommendations for Officials:

- Bring personal hand sanitizer. Wash hands frequently.
- Do not share equipment.
- Follow social distancing guidelines. Consider six feet minimum distance when talking to others (players, coaches, other officials).
- Electronic whistles are permitted if an official prefers to use one. Electronic whistles are not required.
- Do not shake hands including in the pre-game and post-game ceremony.
- Cloth face coverings/masks must be worn at all times with the exception of active officiating, and warm-up.
