



Mayfield High School Hockey Regulations

General Protocols

Anyone feeling sick or that have been exposed to someone sick, should not attend or participate in competitions or practices.

Mayfield team members, coaches, officials, and volunteers will be screened on arrival.

Visiting teams must complete symptom screenings and temperature checks before arriving at the pool.

Spectators must conduct a symptom assessment before entering the facility.

All coaches, spectators, event staff, and athletes not actively participating in physical activity must wear a mask/face covering at all times.

Team members must have their own water bottles, masks, and towels. No equipment is to be shared

Do not shake hands or fist bump other officials, athletes, or coaches.

No congregating before or after practices or games.

Six feet of physical distancing must be maintained between individuals/family groups.

All players must sanitize their hands should their gloves be removed before and after warm-ups and at period breaks.

All those on the bench shall observe six feet of physical distancing.

Everyone on the bench must wear a mask.

Players should arrive to the facility dressed or partially dressed and plan to leave the facility the same way to avoid locker rooms

Game Protocols

Benches

Maintain physical distancing as much as possible

Limit bench personnel to only those that are essential including the penalty boxes

Team Captains

Captains must maintain physical distancing when talking to with an official

Physical distancing must be maintained during pre-game meeting between captains and head coaches.

Protective Equipment

Cloth face coverings are permissible and must cover the individual's nose, mouth, and chin
Plastic shields covering the entire face, unless it is integrated into the face mask/attached on the inside of the mask and clear, are not permissible

Athletes should refrain from removing mouthguards while on the ice

If mouthguards are removed on the sideline or in the bench area, the athlete should use hand sanitizer after replacing the mouthguard.

Post-Game Ceremony

Post-game handshakes or fist bumps are suspended

Recommendations for Officials:

- Facial coverings must be worn at all times with the exception of active officiating or warm-up
- Perform a symptom screening and take temperature prior to arriving at the facility
- Six feet of physical distancing required during pre and post-game conference and during the stoppage of play during games
- Do not shake hands or fist bump other officials, players, or coaches
- Arrive to the facility dressed or partially dressed and plan to leave the facility the same way to avoid locker rooms
- Electronic whistles are permitted.
