



Blue Ace Families,

I am reaching out to provide you with an update related to the latest announcement from Governor DeWine, as it has led to advancements for school sports.

Granville Athletic teams in grades 7 -12 will now move into the Governor's Phase 2 plan. We will continue to prioritize student safety. It is important to understand that this is a very fluid situation, and the state of Ohio or Granville Schools may make adjustments as needed.

PHASE 2: JUNE 22

Listed below is important information you need to be aware of during Phase 2.

General Information

- Open gyms/open fields/workouts/training for Contact Sports may begin
- All NON/LOW-Contact sports may continue with inter-squad competitions
- All open gyms/open fields/workouts/training/practices are voluntary
- Students will be permitted to use the locker rooms
- Restrooms will be available only in the athletic hallway
- There is no restriction on the number permitted to attend open gyms/fields/facilities; any individuals not participating in inter-squad play or skill sessions must remain socially distanced
- Appropriate social distancing should be maintained on sidelines and benches
- Tape and signs will be used in indoor spaces as a guide for students and coaches
- Masks are recommended by all participants when not engaging in physical activity
- Students are not to gather on school grounds before or after training sessions
- If a student is symptomatic, they will be sent home immediately

Prior to Arriving

- **Parents are to take the temperature of students at home. If a student has an elevated temperature, they do NOT attend the training session.**
- If a student is in any way symptomatic, they do NOT attend the training session.
- Any athlete who reports a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher cannot return to practice until they are fever free for at least 3 days without the use of fever reducing medication.
- Students should wear clean clothes every day.
- Students should clean personal equipment every day before leaving home.
- Parents will remain in their vehicles at all times when dropping off or picking up their student.

- Students will check in with their coach, answer symptom-related questions, and wash their hands upon arrival.
- Students are not permitted to carpool to and from training sessions.
- Students will wash their hands for 20 seconds with warm water and soap upon participating in workouts. Handwashing stations will be designated for each group.

Items Needed

- Personal water bottle (water will not be provided at the school)
- Shirts and shoes should be worn at all times
- Sharing of personal equipment will not be permitted (towels, clothing, shoes, etc.)
- Personal hand sanitizer, if desired

Training Session

- Physical distancing will be practiced when not playing and on the sidelines and benches. (6 ft. distancing within the group)
- All athletic equipment including balls, will be cleaned intermittently during practices and between practice/sessions.

Conclusion of the Workout

- Students are not to gather on school grounds before or after workouts.
- Students are not permitted to carpool to and from training sessions.
- All equipment is cleaned prior to re-using.
