

Auburn High School Track and Field 2020-2021

Team Information and Expectations

Practice:

Practice will be held Monday-Friday immediately following school until 5:45 pm at Auburn High School. Athletes from Auburn Junior High School will ride the athletic bus to AHS. All athletes will dress out for practice in the AHS locker rooms and meet outside of the track office to sign in for practice each day. Athletes will be picked up from practice outside of the athletic building promptly at 5:45 pm.

Meet Schedule:

The full meet schedule is found on the back of this page. However, we host several track meets at Auburn High School and will need volunteers to smoothly run these events.

Student Eligibility:

Students cannot participate in practice or meets until they have a current physical on file along with all of the completed paperwork found under the "Student Athlete Eligibility" tab of the ACS Athletic Department page. This paperwork will all be digitally uploaded through the Dragonfly Max app. Athletes must also be in good standing academically and behaviorally with all teachers and classes.

Team Fees and Team Store:

The team fee for track and field is \$50. If your athlete needs a uniform, the total cost is \$50 (\$25 for the top and \$25 for the shorts). Both team and uniform fees can be paid on My School Bucks. We will also have an online Nike Team Store for additional gear and team apparel, but anything from the team store is optional.
