Good Morning Waverly High School Students and Families,

I hope that you have been able to enjoy the last few days of beautiful golf, fishing, or any outside time weather. The purpose of reaching out is to update you on some of the Directed Health Measures and NSAA guidelines as they pertain to school sponsored activities.

The latest Directed Health Measures and subsequent NSAA Guidelines prohibit any school activities in the areas of football, basketball, wrestling, soccer, cheerleading, and summer camps/clinics. Outside of these areas member schools can operate voluntary Strength & Conditioning Sessions (which has already been communicated), open gyms, open field, and facility use for bands, Cologuard, dance, choir, and theaters while adhering to the restrictions in place beginning June 1st, 2020.

Waverly High School has prepared to begin with summer strength and training sessions on Monday, June 8th. Other areas of facility use by school sponsored groups will open beginning **June 10th**. Procedures and protocols for each area will be in place and mirror those that have been established and communicated for weight room use. Groupings will need to be predetermined for each area. We will do our best to keep groups the same as we have established for weight room use, however we understand that will not be a reality in each situation. In this case, our coaches/sponsors will be using their specific communication platforms to reach students and parents to create specific groups as necessary.

The health and safety of all students and staff remains the focus of School District #145. Please know that if you or your family is not comfortable sending students at this time it will not have any impact on team or squad placements for the 2020-2021 academic year. We simply ask that you communicate with the head coach/sponsor so they are aware. As I've mentioned in previous communications, it is very important to remember the better job we do this summer, the greater chances we have of continued and expanded opportunities moving forward. We all have a responsibility in this situation and I have the utmost confidence we all will exceed those responsibilities.

As stated in Dr. Worrell's previous message, our facilities, including our campus green spaces, remain closed to open community use, youth sport organizations or other entities not officially sponsored by the NSAA, NCA, or directly school sponsored groups. Our facilities and green spaces will be off limits through the month of June.
