Senior Kahea Figueira finished 3rd overall at the GSL

**Championship meet at Central Valley on April 3rd, highlighting a
solid team performance and a middle-of-the-pack 5th place team
finish (in line with the girls' 4-4 regular season GSL record). Kahea
matched her lifetime PR with a 19:03 on the rolling 5k layout.**
