It took the Thunderhawks 4 extra minutes of overtime to overcome the upset minded Comets as East escaped by a score of 65-63. Jadon Coles scored on a driving layup with 4 seconds remaining in OT, then a last second Mason trey attempt feel short to seal the win.</p> <p>East got out to an early lead in the game, but the started piling up personal fouls sending Mason to the line throughout the most of the first half. In addition, the Comets took advantage of numerous opportunities on the offensive boards and turning those rebounds into points. East was able to keep Mason's lead to just 5 points at the break.</p> <p>The Thunderhawks surged back in the third quarter outscoring Mason 13-9 but the game remained tight with neither team finding it easy to open up a lead. Senior Nate Johnson scored most of his game leading 25 points in the final two quarters before fouling out early in OT.</p> <p>St. Xavier transfer Jack Kronauge made significant contributions in the contest scoring 14 points, while junior Jadon Coles offensive prowess (11 points) was a difference maker when East needed consistency floor leadership.</p> <p>East goes to 2-0 early in the season and has announced some significant schedule changes.
