

Minutes for April 12, 2021 Zoom Booster Meeting

Treasurer: Current Assets at \$93000 and Current Liabilities \$9500. Not a big revenue month for concessions but they are still have an overall net positive income. We are still in a strong financial position. We are able to help Rich pay for several things even with the situation we've been in all year. All expenses that we know of are paid. The basketball team fundraiser money is still in the checking account and will be dispersed soon. We have no Bingo check yet for this month. The check deposited in March was for February and March after expenses. We have fulfilled our commitment to the stadium entrance as well. We had an executive board meeting with Rich last week and the following items were approved: Hudl contract \$8000 Cameras are down now but are being worked on. Chatterbox contract \$10000. Neptune Music (Lakota East Radio) \$4800. This will update the music currently being played for the Stadium, Baseball, Softball and Basketball arena. We can sell ads to cover this cost. Ads will be approximately \$500 each. Website upgrade to Legend Webworks \$4200. "Go Hawks Go" will be the name of the new site. Should be up and running by August for fall sports. Will be much more user friendly. Signage on top of the Stadium entrance - \$5000. Will be a white "Lakota East" sign with lights in front of the lettering.

Concessions: No report. A new grill was purchased and works really well. They are trying to be open for business as much as possible for all sports.

Spirit Shop: Not a lot happening again. The Concession gals have been selling stuff for the Spirit shop including the last 4 stadium chairs we had. A 20% off sale will be promoted thru our Facebook account thru the end of the year to try to move more inventory. Matt Bachmann will send out an email about getting set up on the new credit card machine. The new shop that will be in the stadium entrance is really nice. There is a lot of space

Membership: We have 1 new 1 year member and 3 new lifetime memberships. Boys lacrosse and Baseball have both reached 50% membership to roster.

Team Reports:

Boys Volleyball – No report

Girls Lacrosse – The girls and coaches would like to thank the Boosters for the neck gaiters, new lacrosse balls and goals. JV's record is 3-1, beating the other school (West) 5-2 on Thursday. Varsity is 2-2. After playing 2 girls down the entire 2nd half and some bad calls they lost to West on Thursday. The girls have 3 games this week at Miamisburg, Sycamore and Milford. They return home next week against Mason on Tuesday the 20th. They are dealing with injuries and quarantines as well.

Boys Lacrosse – Varsity is 1-2 GMC and 2-4 overall. They have a solid team this year, best in 5 years. They lost a tough one in triple OT and a sudden death shootout to West on Thursday.

Track – No report. There is a meet tonight.

Softball – No JV team this year, only varsity. They are now 2-5. Their new rep, Uyen Sims, mentioned that they are in need of a new pitching machine as the motor is out on the current one. Request is for \$1500. Jeff will work the particulars out with Rich to take care of it.

Baseball – Varsity had a big win against previously undefeated Hamilton tonight. Evan Whiteaker had 17 strikeouts. They are now 5-1 in the GMC and 7-3 overall. As of 4/1/21 JV is undefeated and the Freshman team is 7-1. Senior night is May 5th against West. They play Hamilton again on Wednesday and Fairfield on Friday.
