ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT

Spring Sports Information Night – hoping to inspire parents to have sports physicals complete in a more timely fashion and to avoid ineligible players.

Suggestion was made to have more physicians on site to assist with physicals to avoid lengthy wait times.

Looking at dates in May, July and November

Huddle – AD is looking at packages for an extended Huddle offering.

Top level package (\$20,000/yr) – includes huddle focus – 2 cameras mounted in the gym and 2 mobile units.

Mid-level package (\$13,000/yr) – 1 camera in the gym and no mobile units

**Purpose of the systems would be to record sports and offer highlight reels for players and film to be review by SPS coaching staff and to share with other schools.

Coach Communication/Initiative – AD is attempting to create a different role with coaches to increase communication. Many avenues being discussed via social media:
