Emphasizing and improving the sportsmanship of our student-athletes, coaches, parents and staff is one of our highest priorities. Each coach, student, parent and staff member has a role and responsibility to model and teach good sportsmanship while keeping in mind that athletic participation is a learning experience for the student and the programs are an extension of the educational system offered within our school district.

The Chelan Goat Sportsmanship Guidelines:

- Understand the rules and strategies of the contest in order to cheer at the proper times.
- Maintain enthusiasm and composure.
- Positively support the participants, coaches, and officials.
- Exercise good judgment in cheering for outstanding performance, not against opponents or to ridicule an error made by those on the field or court.
- Follow the cheerleaders in positive cheers to show support for all participants.
- Show respect and concern for an injured player, regardless of team.
- Respect decisions made by contest officials.
- Realize that a ticket represents a privilege to observe and positively support a high school activity. It is not a license to verbally assault others or to be generally obnoxious.
- Respect all fans, coaches, officials and participants.
- Encourage surrounding fans to display only positive sportsmanlike conduct.
- Display pride and respect in our programs at all times.
