

Chris Ceresa

Chris is currently the Director of Fund Development for Huron Valley Schools and will be making his return to coaching this spring as the head coach of the Milford track & field program. Chris, a 1981 graduate, was a 4-year letter winner in Track & Field and set the freshman class record in the Shot Put. A record that stood for 18 years until he coached Rich Baron who broke that record. He still ranks among Milford's top All-Time Marks in the Shot Put and Discus. During his 20 years as a teacher and coach Chris coached football, golf, cross country and track & field. He also served as Director of Athletics at Milford High School for 7 years from 2007 to 2015.



Chris' coaching record speaks for itself. During his leadership Milford Track & Field program earned an incredible 120 dual meet wins compared to only 21 losses. His teams amassed 7 undefeated seasons, 10 Kensington Valley Conference Championships, 5 MHSAA Regional Championships, and 2 MITCA Team State Championships. The awards and accolades were not only limited to team successes as he coached 87 individual conference champions, 23 MHSAA Regional champions, and 4 MHSAA State champions. Not only did he coach 87 Conference Champions, but they represented all 17 events in track and field, demonstrating his vision and value on all elements of the sport. Fifteen current Milford Hall of Famers ran track & field for Chris including this year's inductees Dan DeRusha and Eric D'Andrea.

In 2015 he was recognized as the Oakland County Athletic Director of the Year. Chris and his wife Sylvia currently reside in South Lyon, but can be found at Milford Athletic events throughout the year.
