Written Operation Plan for NTHS Gymnasium

1. SEATING CAPACITY

There is a limited seated capacity of 150 spectators, which is 15% of our maximum capacity of 1000. We would like to increase this capacity to a maximum of 170 to allow each NT athlete 4 tickets and opposing team athletes 2 tickets each.

2. TICKET SALES

Tickets for spectators will be pre-sold online only. No general admission tickets will be sold.
A-National Trail student-athletes will receive 4 tickets.
B-Opposing teams will receive 50 tickets to distribute as they see fit.

3. SPECTATOR DISTANCING

Seating will be marked for social distancing at 6' using tape to mark off seats.
A-Seating pods will be limited to no more than 4 people per pod. Each pod should be family members only.
B-There will be a minimum of 6' between each pod.
C-Seating pods will be staggered by row.

4. ENTRANCE INTO FACILITY

There will be entrances into the gym area, one each for the home and visiting teams.
A-Home team spectators shall enter the school facility through one of the 2 main entryways on the commons area (Doors #1 and #13). Upon entering the High School, they will get tickets scan and enter the north side of the gym.
B-Visiting team spectators shall enter the school facility through the south parking lot entry (Door #22). Upon entering the facility, they will have tickets scanned and enter the south side of the gym.
C-At each side, the right side door will be marked as the entrance door and the left door the exit door. (Sides determined from standing outside of the gym)

5. EXITING THE FACILITY

There will be 2 exits for spectators.
A-When exiting the facility, home spectators will be asked to exit through the commons area with the main entrance. (Doors #1, #13)
B-When exiting the facility, visiting spectators will be asked to exit through the south side entry (Door #22)

6. SANITIZATION

The facility will be cleaned and sanitized after each event.

A-Common touch areas, such as handrails and bathroom doors will be cleaned periodically throughout each event.

B-Hand sanitizer will be located at strategic points during each event for easy access to spectators and game personnel.

C-Locker rooms will be cleaned before and after each event.

7. EQUIPMENT

Event equipment will be sanitized as frequently as possible.

A-Before each event, game equipment will be sanitized.

B-The game ball will be sanitized between each game, between quarters and during timeouts.

C-Pre-game equipment will be sanitized before and after each event.

D-Warm up balls will be on separate racks with 6 balls for each team. They will be sanitized before and after each event.

8. OFFICIALS

Officials will be separated from the spectators as much as possible for their safety.

A-Officials will enter and exit the facility using back door entrance (door #17).

B-Officials will be able to use the Boys PE Locker Room if they would need a locker room area.

C-Officials will be provided disposable water bottles from the concession stand if they do not bring their own with them.

9. GAME PERSONNEL

Game personnel will consist of players, coaches, administration, score keepers, book keepers and other personnel deemed necessary to carry out each event.

A-These personnel will not be counted toward the limited capacity.

B-Personnel will be deemed necessary at the discretion of NTLA Administration and Athletic Department.

10. FACIAL COVERINGS

Facial coverings MUST be worn by all spectators, players and game personnel that are not on the playing court.

A-Ushers will be used to monitor this requirement.

B-Exceptions are outlined in ODH Order dated 8/19.

11. CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be available and will follow all Preble County Health Department guidance and requirements for food prep and service.

12. LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be available to all players.

A-Showering is not permitted.

B-Time spent in locker rooms will be limited.

C-Locker rooms will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each event.
