

OLYMPIA HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS

FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

If you are a foreign exchange student interested in participating in athletics, you must have the following items completed and turned in, in advance of the start date for the sport in which you wish to participate.

- Copy of your Visa
- Copy of your birth certificate
- Copy of your I-20. Your I-20 must be for 12 months. Students with six (6) month I-20 are unable to participate per FHSAA (Florida High School Athletic Assoc.) policies
- FHSAA form EL4/ FHSAA form GA4
- Transcripts from the 8th grade through your most completed grade level. You will need to turn in one set of transcripts that are original and in your native language, and you will need to turn in a set of transcripts that are translated into English. You can translate your transcripts by simply putting a line through a word and writing in English in available space near the strike through.

Please Note: This process can take at least 30 days at the start of the school year. Please hand deliver this information to the Olympia High School front office in care of Athletics. Please do not email this information, as the volume will shut down the Athletic Director's inbox.
