

Hello Napavine Families,

We are very excited to announce that we will start athletic activities next week. Obviously, our sports will look very different from what we are normally used to. The process of getting athletic activities off the ground has been a very tasking and frustrating process. Our goal was to get students back competing and participating with the hopes of allowing at least parents being able to watch the activity. We have worked very hard to accomplish this goal and we are going to need your help in making sure we can successfully continue with all of the activities. I have listed the following protocols, procedures and expectations that everyone must follow in order for us to be successful in moving forward.

Purchase of Tickets

The state has limited us to 200 people per event. This number includes players, coaches, officials and game operators. The Central 2B League has decided to only allow home team fans to be in attendance for the 2020-21 athletic seasons. In order to comply with the 200 people per event. The tickets will need to be purchased by no later than 2:15pm the day of the home event. All tickets will need to be purchased at the HS office. When you come to the event, you will need to present the tickets to the ticket taker. **There will be NO opportunity to purchase tickets at the event.** On the back of the ticket, there will be a self-attestation that needs to be completed and turned in when you enter the gate at the facility.

With the exception of varsity football, each student will have four (4) tickets available to purchase for each **home event** they are participating in. Due to the limitations on attendance and the number of participants, we are only able to allow two (2) tickets per player at home football contests. Normal ticketing costs will apply to all home games.

Masks

Masks will be required to be **worn properly at all times** when on school property. The mask must be worn over the nose and must cover the mouth. A refusal to comply with this requirement will result in not being able to attend future school events and the game could be suspended or immediately cancelled. The student athletes have worked so hard and deserve the opportunity to participate, so please help us comply with the requirement so our student athletes can compete successfully in their activities.

Social Distancing

Please stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arm lengths) away from people who are not from your household at both indoor and outdoor activities.

Away Events

Napavine fans/parents will not be able to attend events that are on the road or in other locations. **Napavine parents will be able to attend home events only.**

Live Streaming

All Napavine Middle/High School home games will be streamed (online) on the NFHS Network. The cost of this service is \$10 per month. Most other schools will be using the NFHS platform as well and your \$10 subscription will allow you to watch events at those schools as well. There will be a link on our website for you to access the live streaming on the school website. Here is the link to the live streaming events at Napavine.

Completion of Games:

As soon as the last event is completed, parents will need to exit the facility to their car. We are not allowed to congregate after the event. After meeting with their coaches and team, athletes will also exit the facility to meet their parents at their cars. We are no longer able to wait in the gym or at the stadium when the event is completed. Please help us in making this a successful transition.

Important Message:

I want to kindly remind you of the purpose for these various activities. These events are for our student athletes and their experience. Our athletes need activities for their mental health. We worked very hard to try to include parents in this experience. We are asking you to comply with all the requirements necessary to allow these activities to continue. If you can't comply or don't agree with the requirements, we are asking you to watch your child online. We want you to be aware that if our adults can't follow the requirements of mask wearing and social distancing at the event, the event could be cancelled or immediately suspended by the supervisors. We are asking you to help us in making this a great and worthwhile event for our student athletes. Go Tigers!
