Immunization Requirements for 2019-2020 School Year

- All Students entering kindergarten must show complete immunization for DTaP, Polio, Hepatitis B, MMR and Varicella.
- All students entering 7th grade are required to have TDaP (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) and Meningitis vaccines.
- All students entering the 12th grade are required to have Meningitis vaccine given on or after the age of 16.

If unsure if your child is up to date with immunizations please contact your family doctor or the Sidney-Shelby County Health Department at 937-498-7249.

The Sidney-Shelby County Health Department offers Immunization Clinics Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00AM-11:30AM & 12:30PM-2:30PM with extended hours the first and third Wednesday of each month until 6:00PM. Call the health department to schedule an appointment.

The health department will also be hosting Immunization Clinic for Ft. Loramie students during the sports physicals on May 15th from 6:30PM – 9:30PM at Ft. Loramie School.
