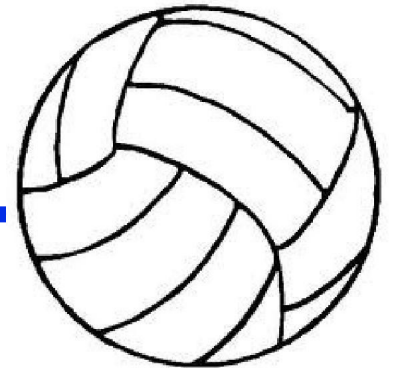

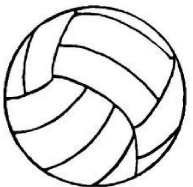

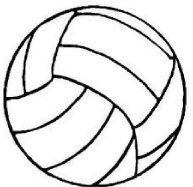

Tryouts and Commitment Night



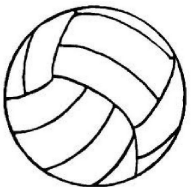
- Tentative tryout date Saturday May 1, 2021
 - Tryouts based on FCS – COVID 19 plan
 - **The girls must have a school physical completed in the previous 12 months BEFORE they can participate in tryouts**
 - Free physicals for student athletes?
- A virtual commitment night and fee payment will occur the week following tryouts - please plan your budgets accordingly
- Every player **MUST** register for tryouts at:

 - Click “confirm and pay”, but there is **NO FEE** to register
- We will use the email contact list from the Pickle Juice tryouts registration to send out information going forward, so it's imperative that you register at the site!



Registration Paperwork



- ALL Paperwork needs to be completed online via DragonFly (www.dragonflymax.com) prior to Summer Conditioning
- Each new family needs to set up an account (one account per family/includes all sports) and upload a 2021-22 completed physical
 - Returning players - log into your account and you will see the 2021-22 paperwork loaded and ready to be completed

Program Funding



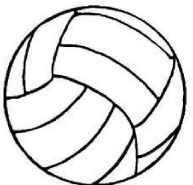
- Participation and Registration Fees
 - We will be changing to a tiered-fee structure per below:
 - Freshmen team = \$350
 - JV team = \$400
 - Varsity team = \$450
 - Participation and Registration fee will be due by Commitment Night
 - Players from the Freshmen 2020 team will be given a \$100 credit towards their registration fee for the 2021 season. Those who do not continue in the program will be refunded the money
- Fees cover the following items:
 - Uniform rental (excluding black spandex, white socks, kneepads, and shoes)
 - All tournaments, games and summer conditioning
 - Coaches for 3 teams and game officials
 - Bus transportation to and from games
 - CHS Umbrella Booster club fee





Program Funding (cont.)

- Fees typically do not adequately cover:
 - Assistant coaches
 - Pre-game meals
 - Summer camp
 - End of year banquet
- Other sources of revenue
 - Corporate & Family Sponsorships
 - Paint Can Fundraiser (August 28, 2021)
 - Spirit Wear Sales
 - Concessions
 - Other fundraising opportunities



Player Expectations

- Maintain your academics

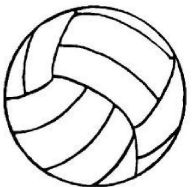
These are competitive teams, not recreational – we expect your full commitment to make this a successful season

- Model respectful and good sportsmanship behavior

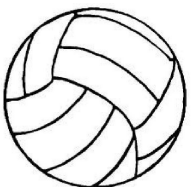


* Training will be provided before the season begins

Anticipated Summer Schedule



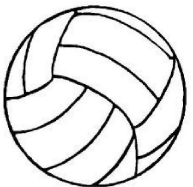
- Team Summer Camp*
 - Varsity: overnight camp on college campus in mid-July
 - JV & Freshmen teams: day-time local camp in mid-July
- Summer camps are highly encouraged (but not mandatory) – please communicate with your coach if you are unable to attend
- Summer conditioning will start week of July 12
- **First official practice early August**



Fall Schedule



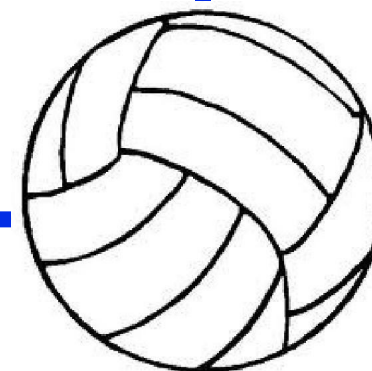
- Season starts early August - early Oct (Freshmen & JV), and early Nov (Varsity)
- Mandatory Pre-Season/Summer Workouts: (Start TBD)
 - Conditioning: 6:30-8:00 AM
 - Practice: 4:00-6:00 PM
- Regular season practice: everyday after school from 4-6pm
- Game days
 - Varsity: Tuesdays & Thursdays
 - Freshmen & JV: Mondays & Wednesdays
