Girls Gymnastics Camp June 22-24, 2021

Benefiting the LPHS Girls Gymnastics Team



Camp focuses on skill introduction and development on all four events (vault, uneven bars, balance beam, and floor exercise). This camp is structured for beginners and intermediate gymnasts.

WHO: Girls entering **Kindergarten through 8th** for the 2021-22 school year; no previous experience required. Girls will be placed in groups by age and ability.

WHAT: LPHS Girls Summer Gymnastics Day Camp coached by the LPHS Coaches and Gymnasts. Campers will practice on all four events (vault, uneven bars, balance beam and floor) and learn a group dance. Parents are invited to come and watch the camp finale performance the last 15 minutes of camp on Thursday.

WHEN: **Tuesday, June 22, Wednesday, June 23 and Thursday, June 24**

Session 1 – 2-3:30pm (K-4th)

Session 2 – 3:30-5:30pm (5th-8th)

WHERE: LPHS Fieldhouse Gymnastics Area

COST: \$35 campers K-4th; \$40 campers 5th-8th

\$5 off registration for additional siblings enrolled. Every camper who pre-registers by Friday, May 28, 2021 gets a t-shirt.

Gymnasts are to wear a fitted leotard or an athletic/fitted t-shirt or tank top with athletic/fitted shorts. Each gymnast must bring her own bottle of water labeled with her name.
