We would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the athletic training services that are provided to the student athletes at Medina High School.

Luis DeJesus and Scott Horton are the Certified Athletic Trainers contracted to Medina High School. As nationally certified and Ohio licensed athletic trainers, we are educated and skilled in the services of injury prevention, injury recognition/evaluation, and orthopedic rehabilitation, in addition to acute first aid and trauma care. As the Athletic Trainers at Medina High School, we are here to meet the medical health and safety needs of your child. Our top priority is administering quality healthcare to meet the needs of our student-athlete population. We are at the high school daily to provide coverage for practices and all contracted home game contests.

Unfortunately, not all injuries can be treated in the Athletic Training Room. If an injured athlete requires additional medical attention, we are fortunate to have Dr. Dominic King, DO from the Cleveland Clinic as team physician for our school. Dr. King is an orthopedic physician who treats athletes at the Cleveland Clinic Brunswick Family Health Center as well as at the Cleveland Clinic Middleburg Height office.

In addition to Dr. King, we have the entire network of Cleveland Clinic Sports Health physicians available for referral should the instance arise. As medical professionals employed to the school, we can provide priority scheduling with any one of our sports medicine physicians. We will make every effort to evaluate, refer, and facilitate physician appointments with the appropriate Cleveland Clinic physician. Our goal is to alleviate the stress associated with injury by providing easier access to top level care, follow-up information, and appropriate return to sport care.
