-In 2017 was \$2,279.48 and it was working.

\*Toni Ovens was stocking the machine and now a group from the high school along with their teacher, Heather Horton, are buying and stocking the machine as a learning tool for the class.

\*There will be an Athletic Boosters sign placed on the vending machine.

\*Athletic Boosters will receive a rebate during the 1st year with certain candy bars and chips stocked which will give a 100% profit.

\*With the rebate the vending machine will pay for itself within the 1st year.
