Before trying out for a KML athletic team, it is important for both participant and parents to know what is involved with team membership. **If you are not in agreement with the following points, then do not allow your child to tryout.** If you do agree, then this form must be signed before your child will be allowed to tryout.

- 1. Physical Risk** By participating in an athletic activity at KML, a person exposes himself/herself to the risk of serious injury, including but not limited to the risk of: sprains, fractures, and ligament and/or cartilage damage, which could result in temporary or permanent, partial or complete impairment in the use of limbs; brain damage; or even death.
- 2. Finances and Insurance** Tuition accounts are expected to be current (see Student Handbook). *"No student will be allowed to participate in any co-curricular activities if any portion of their account is more than 90 days past due."* Anyone participating in athletics should have adequate health insurance. KML is not responsible for covering the insurance deductible or copay.
- 3. Dedication** Team membership calls for dedication. This dedication is displayed in a variety of ways including such things as: regular attendance at school, being prompt for class, maintaining proper Christian conduct, being well-prepared for class, being at practice promptly and regularly, and being on time for games. Student athletes represent the school at all times. Therefore, conduct outside of school may jeopardize participation. Be especially aware that social network website statements and/or pictures might affect the student athlete's reputation, as well as the reputation of their parents and the school (see more information in Student Handbook under Social Media). Jobs may not interfere with regularly scheduled practices or contests. Practice schedules are available well in advance to avoid potential conflicts. Student athletes will be disciplined for detentions, missed practices, and missed games and such problems could lead to dismissal from the team.
- 4. Training Rules** An athlete must take good care of his/her body. During their years of participation, all KML athletes are expected to follow training rules throughout the calendar year. Basic rules are listed below. Additional important information is found under "Co-curricular Activities" in the Student Handbook.
 - A. No use of tobacco or electronic smoking devices, drinking alcoholic beverages, or use or possession of illegal drugs will be allowed.
 - B. Partaking of proper nutrition and maintaining regular sleeping hours, especially prior to contests, is expected so that athletes may give peak performance.
- 5. Equipment/Uniform Policy** It is understood that parent and athlete are responsible for promptly returning all equipment and uniforms in good condition or will need to pay for the replacement or repair of such items. Uniforms are to be returned within one week after the final contest of the season. Late fees will be assessed after one week.
- 6. Team Lockers** Each team member is assigned a locker in the team locker room during a sport season. Lockers must be emptied and cleaned one week after the season ends. A \$10 fine will be assessed for non-compliance.
