**WINTER SPORTS HOME EVENT COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN & TICKET GUIDELINES**

**Statement of Understanding:**

- Following the Ohio Department of Health order issued on *September 25, 2020*, Kent City Schools and the Roosevelt and Stanton Athletic Departments will follow the protocols below regarding **HOME** spectator safety, attendance and ticket guidelines for the winter sport season of 2020-2021 in the sports of basketball, ice hockey, swim, bowling and wrestling.
- The guidelines below are meant to provide every coach, athlete and parent the safest environment at each Kent City Schools athletic venue.
- To follow the strict attendance guidelines put forth by the Ohio Department of Health and the City of Kent Health Department, ticket policies may vary throughout the winter season by sport for all home events.
- With a variety of facilities in our league, there may be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue where we are playing on the road.
- The Kent City Schools compliance officer will be Mark Pfaff, Roosevelt High School Athletic Director. The Kent City School's event contact staff members will vary at each home athletic event. The following individuals will be contact staff for various home events:

**Ice Hockey at The Pond and Winterhurst Ice Arena**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Fans should enter the arena when permitted by arena staff.
  - All fans will have their temperature taken prior to entering the arena.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the ice arena pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the arena.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - Fans should not congregate before or after the game. Please exit the arena immediately.
  - **Only one (1) fan per player will be permitted into the arena, based on rosters submitted by the head coaches.**

- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- **For the safety of the ice hockey players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Franklin.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at The Pond and/or Winterhurst.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Players must remain in the team bench areas at all times where masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

### **General Guidelines and Ticket Information**

- **THE POND AND WINTERHURST HAS THE RIGHT TO LIMIT ACCESS TO THEIR FACILITY.**
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- Fans are reminded to practice required social distancing while waiting in line.
- To comply with the 15% attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each Roosevelt player will be permitted one (1) guest to each game.
- The visiting school will be allocated one (1) guest per game.
- Fans will pay for their ticket upon arrival at The Pond or Winterhurst.
- All tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$6.00 each.
- Seating in family pods is recommended.

### **Basketball (Varsity & JV) at Roosevelt High School**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Fans should enter Roosevelt Gym through the doors on each side of the gym, staying on the right side of doors when entering and exiting the gym.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the gym pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the gym.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods on or near a painted dot and maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - **NO** congregating before or after the game.
- **For the safety of the basketball players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Roosevelt High School.

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Players must remain in the **team bleacher areas** at all times where masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- **For the safety of the cheerleaders:**
  - Cheerleaders must maintain a 6 ft. social distance.
  - All cheers and chants must be outside the 6 ft. social distance guidelines.

### **General Basketball Ticket and Facility Guidelines**

- All basketball fans with tickets should park in and around the school in the Roosevelt High School parking lots.
- To comply with the 15% gym attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each Roosevelt player and cheerleader on the roster will have available TWO (2) tickets for each **HOME** game.
- The visiting school will be allocated two (2) tickets each for player and cheerleader on the roster.
- Fans will check in at the ticket table by the athlete's name. At which time they will be able to purchase up to two (2) tickets.
- Fans are reminded to practice required social distancing while waiting in line.
- Fans will pay for their tickets upon arrival at Roosevelt High School, then enter the gym through either of the double doors at the south end of the gym.
- All tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- **If you are not purchasing a ticket, you will NOT be allowed on the premises.**
- **Kent City Schools and/or a representative has the authority to remove from the facility anyone that does not comply with the mask ordinance. ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT BASKETBALL GAMES.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the gym. Bottles of water are welcome.
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider volleyball game.

## **Basketball (Freshman) at Roosevelt High School**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Fans should enter Roosevelt Gym through the doors on each side of the gym, staying on the right side of doors when entering and exiting the gym.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the gym pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the gym.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods on or near a painted dot and maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - **NO** congregating before or after the game.
  
- **For the safety of the basketball players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Roosevelt High School.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Players must remain in the **team bleacher areas** at all times where masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

- All freshman tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$3.00.
  
- **If you are not purchasing a ticket, you will NOT be allowed on the premises.**
  
- **Kent City Schools and/or a representative has the authority to remove from the facility anyone that does not comply with the mask ordinance. ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**

- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the gym. Bottles of water are welcome.

### **Wrestling (Varsity & JV) at Roosevelt High School**

  - Fans should enter Roosevelt Gym through the doors on each side of the gym, staying on the right side of doors when entering and exiting the gym.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the gym pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the gym.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods on or near a painted dot and maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - **NO** congregating before or after the match.
- **For the safety of the wrestlers:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Roosevelt High School.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Players must remain in the **team bleacher areas** at all times where masks and social distancing are required while not in the team chairs with their teammates.
  - All wrestlers must wear masks unless actively participating in a match.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pre and post match.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

### **General Wrestling Ticket and Facility Guidelines**

- To comply with the 15% gym attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each Roosevelt player on the roster will have available TWO (2) tickets for each **HOME** match.
- The visiting school will be allocated two (2) tickets each for player on the roster.
- All wrestling fans with tickets should park in and around the school in the Roosevelt High School parking lots.
- Fans will check in at the ticket table by the athlete's name. At which time they will be able to purchase up to two (2) tickets.
- Fans are reminded to practice required social distancing while waiting in line.
- Fans will pay for their tickets upon arrival at Roosevelt High School, then enter the gym through one of the double doors at the south end of the gym.

- All tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- **If you are not purchasing a ticket, you will NOT be allowed on the premises.**
- **Kent City Schools and/or a representative has the authority to remove from the facility anyone that does not comply with the mask ordinance. ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT HOME WRESTLING MATCHES.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the gym. Bottles of water are welcome.
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider volleyball game.
- Seating in family pods is recommended on or near the painted bleacher dots.
- Fans will exit the gym through the double doors at the south end of the gym.
- Fans must exit the gym immediately at the conclusion of the match.

### Swimming & Diving at Roosevelt Natatorium

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - **PER THE CITY OF KENT HEALTH DEPARTMENT, NO FANS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND SWIM MEETS AT THE ROOSEVELT NATATORIUM.**
- **For the safety of the athletes:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Roosevelt High School.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - **All coaches, event workers and officials will wear masks at all times.**
  - Roosevelt athletes must remain in the **team bleacher areas** at all times where masks and social distancing are required at all times.
  - Visiting athletes must remain in the shallow end of the pool area on the pool deck where masks and social distancing are required at all times.
  - Athletes must wear masks unless actively participating in an event.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pre and post meet.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the meet.

## **Bowling (Varsity & JV) at Kent Lanes**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Fans should enter Kent Lanes through the doors at the east end of Kent Lanes, staying on the right side of doors when entering and exiting the facility.
  - Maska are required by all fans entering the facility.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the facility pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility.
  - Fans should sit in family pods only as determined by Kent Lanes..
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the match.
  - **NO** congregating before or after the match.
- **For the safety of the bowlers:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Kent Lanes.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Kent Lanes.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Bowlers must remain in their team area at all times where masks and social distancing are required.
  - Bowlers may not share bowling balls, towels, shoes or any other equipment.
  - Bowlers must wear masks unless actively participating in a match.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pre and post match.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

## **General Bowling Facility Guidelines**

- To comply with the 15% facility attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each Roosevelt player on the roster will be permitted two (2) guests for each **HOME** match.
- The visiting school will **NOT** be permitted to have fans attend matches at Kent Lanes..
- All Bowling fans should park in and around the Kent Lanes parking lots.
- Fans will check in at the ticket table by the athlete's name. At which time they will be permitted to enter the facility.
- Fans are reminded to practice required social distancing while waiting in line and entering Kent Lanes.
- **Kent Lanes has the authority to remove from the facility anyone that does not comply with the mask ordinance. ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the gym. Bottles of water are welcome.
- Fans must exit the facility immediately at the conclusion of the match.
