**SPRING SPORTS HOME EVENT COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN & TICKET GUIDELINES**

**Statement of Understanding:**

- Following the Ohio Department of Health order issued the spring of 2021, Kent City Schools and the Roosevelt and Stanton Athletic Departments will follow the protocols below regarding **HOME** spectator safety, attendance and ticket guidelines for the spring of 2021 in the sports men's and women's lacrosse, baseball, softball and men's volleyball.
- The guidelines below are meant to provide every coach, athlete and parent the safest environment at each Kent City Schools athletic venue.
- To follow the strict attendance guidelines put forth by the Ohio Department of Health, every student athlete will receive a sport specific various number of tickets based on the sport for family members to watch them compete this Spring for each home contest.
- With a variety of facilities in our league and at non-league sites, there may be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue where we are playing on the road.
- The Kent City Schools compliance officer will be Mark Pfaff, Roosevelt High School Athletic Director. The Kent City School's event contact staff members will vary at each home athletic event. The following individuals will be contact staff for various home events:

**Varsity Track and Field**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Roosevelt Stadium will be marked throughout the walkways, bleachers and restrooms with directional arrows to keep the flow of pedestrian traffic moving in the same direction.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the stadium pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the stadium.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Fans will enter the stadium at the ticket booths in the southeast corner of the stadium.
  - Fans will exit the stadium at the southwest corner of the stadium on the visitors side or behind the home stands on the home side of the stadium.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically to provide a safe environment. .
  - **NO** Tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
  
- **For the safety of the track & Field Athletes:**

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.
- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players prior to arrival at Roosevelt Stadium.
- Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only for pregame, halftime and post game.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- All coaches will wear masks at all times.
- Both teams will limit contact with each other pre and post meet..
- Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

### **Ticket and General Guidelines**

- NO tickets will be sold for track meets, however, in order to comply with the 25% stadium attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each Roosevelt and visiting athletes are permitted four(4) guests at track meets.
- ***ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.***
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT TRACK MEETS..**
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider track meets.
- Seating in family pods is recommended.
- Fans will exit the stadium behind the home stands and/or the southwest corner of the stadium.

### **Lacrosse (Varsity & JV):**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Stanton Stadium will be marked throughout the walkways, bleachers and restrooms with directional arrows to keep the flow of pedestrian traffic moving in the same direction.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the stadium pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the stadium.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Fans will enter the stadium at the ticket booth on the west side of the stadium.
  - Fans will exit the stadium on the west side through the double gate next to the Adam S. Hamilton Fitness Center.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.

### **For the safety of the lacrosse players:**

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Stanton Stadium.
- Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- ***All coaches will wear masks at all times.***
- Players must remain in the team bench area at all times where masks and social distancing is required.
- Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
- Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

### **Ticket and General Guidelines**

- To comply with the 30% stadium attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each **Roosevelt** lacrosse player's guest will be able to purchase **THREE (3)** tickets for each contest at Stanton Stadium.
- The **visiting school's players** will be allocated **TWO (2)** tickets per player.
- All lacrosse fans should park in and around the stadium in the Stanton Middle School lots.
- Fans should present their rostered players name at the ticket booth once they arrive at the stadium. At that time, they will be sold a ticket(s) as a guest of the rostered player.
- All tickets will be sold at the Suburban League, general admission price of \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- **Lacrosse fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs in order to social distance throughout Stanont Stadium.**
- ***ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.***
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT SOCCER GAMES.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the stadium. Bottles of water are welcome.
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider lacrosse game.
- Seating in family pods is recommended.
- Fans must leave the facility immediately following the end of the game.
- Fans will exit the stadium through the double gate closest to the Adam S. Hamilton Fitness Center. **FANS SHOULD NOT EXIT NEAR THE TICKET BOOTH.**

### **Volleyball (Varsity & JV):**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Fans should enter the Stanton Gym through the doors, staying on the right side of doors when entering and exiting the gym.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the gym pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.

- Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the stadium.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
  - **NO** tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
- **For the safety of the volleyball players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at Roosevelt High School.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - **NO** locker room use by either team.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - **All coaches will wear masks at all times.**
  - Players must remain in the team beach areas at all times where masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

### **Ticket and General Guidelines**

- To comply with the 25% gym attendance guideline set forth in the ODH order, each rostered **Roosevelt player** will be permitted up to **FOUR (4)** guests for each **HOME** game.
- The **visiting school's rostered athletes** will be permitted to have up to **TWO (2)** guests for each game at Stanton Middle School.
- All volleyball fans with tickets should park in and around the school in the Roosevelt High School parking lots.
- Fans should present their rostered players name at the ticket booth once they arrive at Stanton Middle School. At that time, each fan will be sold a ticket(s) as a guest of the rostered player.
- All tickets will be sold at the Suburban League general admission price of \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.**
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT VOLLEYBALL GAMES.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the stadium. Bottles of water are welcome.
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider volleyball game.
- Seating in family pods is recommended.
- Fans will exit the gym through the double doors at the north end of the gym.
- Fans must exit the gym immediately at the conclusion of each match.

### **Baseball (Varsity & JV):**

- No tickets will be sold for JV or Varsity baseball.
- Players are encouraged to invite only immediate family to all baseball games.

- **For the safety of our fans:**
  - To encourage social distancing and family pods, Roosevelt Park will have very limited bleacher seating for fans to sit during the games.
  - Baseball fans are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs and space themselves around the perimeter of the field while sitting in family pods and social distancing.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the facility pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available at the field.
  - Fans will enter the field through the double gate near the right field foul pole only.
  - Due to the small size of the main gate, fans are encouraged to social distance while entering and exiting the field.
  - NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
  - Fans must exit the field immediately at the conclusion of the game.
- **For the safety of the baseball players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players prior to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - No locker room facilities will be available.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - **All coaches will wear masks at all times.**
  - While in the dugout, masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- **Social distancing throughout the baseball facility is required.**
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD.**
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE FIELD THE ENTIRE TIME.**

### **Softball (Varsity):**

- No tickets will be sold for varsity softball.
- Players are encouraged to invite only immediate family to all softball games.
- **For the safety of our fans:**
  - To encourage social distancing and family pods, the Roosevelt softball field will have very limited bleacher seating for fans to sit during the games.
  - Softball fans are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs and space themselves around the perimeter of the field, including outside the outfield fence, while sitting in family pods and social distancing.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the facility pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available at the field.
  - Fans will enter the field area along the right field line.

- NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
- Fans must exit the field immediately at the conclusion of the game.
- **For the safety of the softball players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the softball field.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players prior to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - No locker room facilities will be available.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - **All coaches will wear masks at all times.**
  - While in the dugout, masks and social distancing are required.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- **Social distancing throughout the softball facility is required.**
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD.**
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE FIELD THE ENTIRE TIME.**

### Men's Tennis (Varsity & JV):

- No tickets will be sold for JV or Varsity Tennis.
- Players are encouraged to invite only immediate family to all tennis matches.
- **For the safety of our fans:**
  - To encourage social distancing and family pods, tennis fans are discouraged from sitting in the bleachers. IF sitting in the bleachers is necessary, social distancing is a must.
  - Tennis fans are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs and space themselves around the tennis courts while sitting in family pods and social distancing.
  - NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
  - Fans must exit the tennis court area immediately at the conclusion of the match
- **For the safety of the tennis players:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the tennis courts.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
  - No locker room facilities will be available.
  - **All coaches will wear masks at all times.**
  - Tennis players should social distance while waiting for their match.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- **Social distancing throughout the tennis facility is required.**
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD.**
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE FIELD THE ENTIRE TIME.**
