SPRING SPORTS HOME EVENT COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN & TICKET GUIDELINES

Statement of Understanding:

- Following the revised Ohio Department of Health order issued the spring of 2021, Kent City Schools and the Roosevelt and Stanton Athletic Departments will follow the protocols below regarding **HOME** spectator safety, attendance and ticket guidelines for the spring of 2021 in the sports men's and women's lacrosse, baseball, softball and men's volleyball.
- The guidelines below are meant to provide every coach, athlete and parent the safest environment at each Kent City Schools athletic venue.
- To follow the strict attendance guidelines put forth by the Ohio Department of Health, every student athlete will receive a sport specific various number of tickets based on the sport for family members to watch them compete this Spring for each home contest.
- With a variety of facilities in our league and at non-league sites, there may be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue where we are playing on the road.
- The Kent City Schools compliance officer will be Mark Pfaff, Roosevelt High School Athletic Director. The Kent City School's event contact staff members will vary at each home athletic event. The following individuals will be contact staff for various home events:

Lacrosse (Varsity & JV):

- **For the safety of the fans:**
 - Stanton Stadium will be marked throughout the walkways, bleachers and restrooms with directional arrows to keep the flow of pedestrian traffic moving in the same direction.
 - Signage will be placed throughout the stadium pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
 - Multiple announcements will be made over the PA pertaining to social distancing and various Covid 19 health protocols.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the stadium.
 - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
 - Fans will enter the stadium at the ticket booth on the west side of the stadium.
 - Fans will exit the stadium on the west side through the double gate next to the Adam S. Hamilton Fitness Center.
 - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically throughout the game.
 - NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.

For the safety of the lacrosse players:

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.
- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players **prior** to arrival at Stanton Stadium.
- Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- ***All coaches will wear masks at all times.***
- Players must remain in the team bench area at all times where masks and social distancing is required.
- Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
- Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

Ticket and General Guidelines

- To comply with the revised 30% stadium attendance guideline set forth in the new ODH order, each rostered **Roosevelt** lacrosse player's will be permitted **THREE (3)** tickets for each contest at Stanton Stadium.
- The **visiting school's rostered players** will be allocated **TWO (2)** tickets per player.
- All lacrosse fans should park in and around the stadium in the Stanton Middle School lots.
- Fans should present their rostered players name at the ticket booth once they arrive at the stadium. At that time, they will be sold a ticket(s), up to three (3), as a guest of the rostered player.
- All tickets will be sold at the Suburban League, general admission price of \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- **Lacrosse fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs in order to social distance throughout Stanton Stadium.**
- ***ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS WHILE IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME.***
- Due to the strict food guidelines during the pandemic, there will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT LACROSSE GAMES.**
- No coolers or outside food will be permitted into the stadium. Bottles of water are welcome.
- We invite our fans to visit our outstanding local restaurants prior to and/or after each Rough Rider lacrosse game.
- Seating in family pods is recommended.
- Fans must leave the facility immediately following the end of the game.
- Fans will exit the stadium through the double gate closest to the Adam S. Hamilton Fitness Center.
- **FANS SHOULD NOT EXIT NEAR THE TICKET BOOTH.**
