SPRING SPORTS HOME EVENT COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN & TICKET GUIDELINES

Statement of Understanding:

- Following the Ohio Department of Health order issued the spring of 2021, Kent City Schools and the Roosevelt and Stanton Athletic Departments will follow the protocols below regarding HOME spectator safety, attendance and ticket guidelines for the spring of 2021 in the sports men's and women's lacrosse, baseball, softball and men's volleyball.
- The guidelines below are meant to provide every coach, athlete and parent the safest environment at each Kent City Schools athletic venue.
- To follow the strict attendance guidelines put forth by the Ohio Department of Health, every student athlete will receive a sport specific various number of tickets based on the sport for family members to watch them compete this Spring for each home contest.
- With a variety of facilities in our league and at non-league sites, there may be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue where we are playing on the road.
- The Kent City Schools compliance officer will be Mark Pfaff, Roosevelt High School Athletic Director. The Kent City School's event contact staff members will vary at each home athletic event. The following individuals will be contact staff for various home events:

Baseball (Varsity & JV):

- No tickets will be sold for JV or Varsity baseball.
- Players are encouraged to invite only immediate family to all baseball games.

• For the safety of our fans:

- To encourage social distancing and family pods, Roosevelt Park will have very limited bleacher seating for fans to sit during the games.
- Baseball fans are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs and space themselves around the perimeter of the field while sitting in family pods and social distancing.
- Signage will be placed throughout the facility pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the field.
- Fans will enter the field through the double gate near the right field foul pole only.
- Due to the small size of the main gate, fans are encouraged to social distance while entering and exiting the field.
- NO tailgating on Kent City Schools property.
- Fans must exit the field immediately at the conclusion of the game.

• For the safety of the baseball players:

■ Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.

- Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players prior to arrival at Roosevelt High School.
- No locker room facilities will be available.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- All coaches will wear masks at all times.
- While in the dugout, masks and social distancing are required.
- Both teams will limit contact with each other for pregame and postgame.
- Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- Social distancing throughout the baseball facility is required.
- NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD.
- ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE FIELD THE ENTIRE TIME.
