### **SPRING SPORTS HOME EVENT COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN & TICKET GUIDELINES**

#### **Statement of Understanding:**

- Following the Ohio Department of Health order issued the spring of 2021, Kent City Schools and the Roosevelt and Stanton Athletic Departments will follow the protocols below regarding **HOME** spectator safety, attendance and ticket guidelines for the spring of 2021 in the sports of track & field, men's and women's lacrosse, baseball, softball and men's volleyball.
- The guidelines below are meant to provide every coach, athlete and parent the safest environment at each Kent City Schools athletic venue.
- To follow the strict attendance guidelines put forth by the Ohio Department of Health, every student athlete will receive a sport specific various number of tickets based on the sport for family members to watch them compete this Spring for each home contest.
- **With a variety of facilities in our league and at non-league sites, there may be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue where we are playing on the road.**
- The Kent City Schools compliance officer will be Mark Pfaff, Roosevelt High School Athletic Director. The Kent City School's event contact staff members will vary at each home athletic event. The following individuals will be contact staff for various home events:

#### **Varsity Track and Field**

- **For the safety of the fans:**
  - Roosevelt Stadium will be marked throughout the walkways, bleachers and restrooms with directional arrows to keep the flow of pedestrian traffic moving in the same direction.
  - Signage will be placed throughout the stadium pertaining to social distancing, sanitization and traffic flow.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the stadium.
  - Fans should sit in the bleachers in family pods or maintain recommended social distancing.
  - Fans will enter the stadium at the ticket booths in the southeast corner of the stadium.
  - Fans will exit the stadium at the southwest corner of the stadium on the visitors side or behind the home stands on the home side of the stadium.
  - Restroom facilities will be sanitized periodically to provide a safe environment. .
  - **NO** Tailgating on Kent City Schools property.

- **For the safety of the track & Field Athletes:**
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for Roosevelt coaches and players as they arrive at the stadium.
  - Temperature checks and screening surveys will take place for visiting coaches and players prior to arrival at Roosevelt Stadium.
  - Very limited locker room use by both teams for restroom purposes only for pregame, halftime and post game.
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
  - All coaches will wear masks at all times.
  - Both teams will limit contact with each other pre and post meet..
  - Both teams must exit the facility immediately after the contest.

  - Ticket information, if applicable, will be provided by the home school.
