2020-21 Athletic Physical Status	Student-Athletes and their parents have agreed (through Final Forms) to go through the screening questions <u>EACH DAY</u> before arriving for a practice or workout. Coaching staffs will look for signs/symptoms before and during workouts. ** If a student arrives with or begins demonstrating signs/symptoms, they will be sent home.			
Hydration	The IHSAA is allowing physicals from last year (2019-20) to be valid for this year (2020-21). In order for your 2019-20 physical to be valid for the 2020-21 school year, student athletes must fill out and return (to their coach) a copy of the IHSAA Sports Health Questionnaire and the Consent and Release Form. Under certain circumstances a new physical may be required. All Final Forms must be completed before student-athletes can attend summer workouts or practices on July 6 th .			
Masks/Coverings	Student athletes will be required to bring their own water bottle/thermos and will not be allowed to share with anyone else. Procedures for refilling will be unique to each workout location.			
Masks/Coverings	Coaches and Student Athletes <u>MUST</u> bring masks with them for workouts. Masks/Coverings should be used if social distancing cannot be maintained. Use of Masks/Coverings will not be required during the workouts, as long as social distancing is maintained.
