I. Call to Order: Angela Lake called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

II. Roll Call:

III. Approval of Agenda:

- Jesse Beck motioned to approve March 2018 agenda
- Jennifer Barrett seconded
- VOTE: All in favor, 0 opposed. APPROVED

IV. Approval of Minutes:

- Jesse Beck motioned to approve February 2018 minutes
- Jennifer Koryciak seconded
- VOTE: All in favor, 0 opposed. APPROVED

V. Public Comment:

- a) Coach Drew wanted to inform the boosters he will be putting in a request to attend the MHSAA Golf Coach Clinic. This clinic will be \$250
- **b)** He also wanted to make sure that the boosters did not have a golf fund set aside for them.
 - Jennifer Barrett has confirmed that this fund has been removed

VI. Financial Report:

Reconciliation Summary, Summary Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Detail were provided;

- a) Reconciliation Summary sheet reflects that as of end of February 28, 2018, there is \$41,355.07 in the United Bank checking account. The balance(s) do not reflect committed funds from prior approvals.
- **b)** Summary Balance Sheet as of February 28, 2018 showed total assets of \$43,596.28, committed funds (liabilities) of \$13,177.77, with total equity equaling \$30,418.51.

- c) Profit & Loss showed a net income as of February 2018 as \$1,748.18.
 - Jennifer Koryciak motioned to approve financial report
 - Heather Jones seconded
 - VOTE: All in favor, 0 opposed. APPROVED.
- **d)** Jennifer Barrett thanked the Boosters for the new financial software. She is excited to starting using the updated version.

VII. New Business:

- **a)** Athletic Request: Cross Country Coach Antel, \$110, reimbursement for clinic in November.
 - Request is for \$220 for two coaches attending conference in January.
 - One HS coach and one MS coach attended
 - 1. Boosters approved (via email) reimbursement for only the High School Coach for \$110.

VIII. Old Business:

- a) Athletic Request: Weight Room, Countdown Clock, \$290 APPROVED \$145.00
 - Outstanding questions, is this for regular school use as well (weight lifting class)?
 If so, Boosters will be willing to possibly pay for half the cost
 - 1. Coach Doupe stated that the classes would use this clock as well.
 - 2. Booster will support half the cost of the clock and hope the school would pay for the other half
 - Heather Jones motioned to approve
 - Jennifer Koryciak seconded
 - VOTE: All in favor, 0 opposed. APPROVED
- **b)** Athletic Request: Various Coaches would like 80 student reward t-shirts for workouts, \$420
 - Outstanding question. Would Middle School students be included in this program
 - Coach Doupe stated that all students would be rewarded
 - The vote was completed via email as all Boosters Members were not present
 - Middle School Students are not to be included on the t-shirt provided.
 - VOTE: 4 Approved, 2 opposed, 1 had not voted. APPROVED
- c) Athletic Request: Girls Varsity Softball, Coach Ritz would like to 16 Bat Backpacks for \$936 APPROVED up to \$1,100
 - Questions from the last meeting
 - 1. What will be embroidered on the bags? Wayland Union Softball
 - 2. Are these school property or do they keep them? *These are for the school part of the uniform*
 - 3. Why 16? Are there that many girls on the team? Typically, there are 12 13 girls on the team but 2 3 girls could be moved up at the end of the season for Ann Arbor / State Tournament
 - a. Boosters would like to have the Boosters Logo added to the bags. Cap the cost at \$1,100
 - Jennifer Koryciak motioned to approve
 - Heather Jones seconded
 - VOTE: All in favor, 0 opposed. APPROVED

- d) Athletic Request: Boys Varsity Tennis, Coach Schaefer would like 30 warmups for \$2,400
 - Questions from the last meeting
 - 1. Have the warmups already been purchased? If so, when were they ordered? Yes, these were received last spring
 - 2. Is the request for both a top and bottom? Yes
 - 3. Why 30? Are that many people on the team? *Typically, there are 18 Varsity and he is hoping for a JV team next year.*
 - Tabled Voting at next meeting.
- e) 2-3 New Board Members are need for next year 2018-2019. Please spread the word. Voting will take place at the June 2018 meeting.

 - a. Soccer Concession Stand will be open for the JV and Varsity games
 - Track Meets need to know how many meets there, conflicting information. Track would need to find their own volunteers for the meets
