Tickets: Regular season tickets for all athletic events are \$5, except for football which is \$6. Tickets can be purchased at the ticket gate beginning 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. Individuals under the age of 10 will be admitted for free when accompanied by a paying adult.

Passes: The following passes will be accepted for regular season events only:

- University High School Athletic Passes: Bearer only
- University High School Faculty ID: Bearer plus immediate family
- Visiting School Faculty ID: Bearer plus one guest
- Orange County Public Schools ID: Bearer only
- Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) issued pass: Bearer only with photo ID
- Florida Athletic Coaches Association (FACA) issued pass: Bearer only with photo ID

Non-regular season events: Tickets for post-season are determined by the FHSAA and passes will not be accepted. The only pass that can be used is the FHSAA State Series pass for the bearer only with a photo ID. District Tournament tickets are \$6 and Regional Tournament tickets are \$7 for all sports other than football. Football Regional Tournament tickets are \$8 and State Semifinal games are \$9.

Managers, student athletic trainers, and cheerleaders: Managers and/or student athletic trainers will be admitted only when properly identified and accompanied by the coach. Cheerleaders must be in uniform and accompanied by the coach.

Bus Parking: Visiting team buses for the outdoor sports will enter campus using the stadium entrance to drop off teams and then park in designated areas. Buses for events held in the gym will enter at the main entrance to drop off teams by the main entrance (iron gates) and then Park in the bus loop.

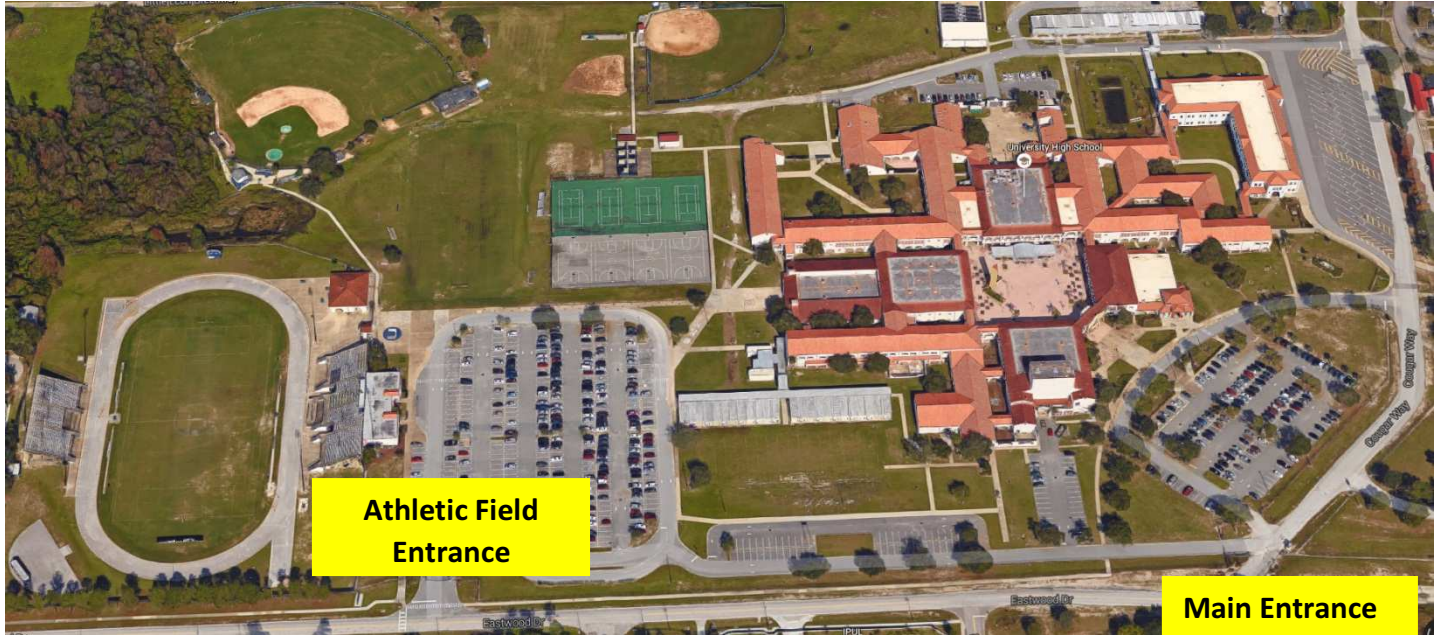
Spectator Parking: Spectators will park in the stadium parking lot for all outdoor sports and follow sidewalks to the appropriate field. For all events held in the gym, spectators need to enter campus at the main entrance to the school and park in the administration parking lot then enter through the iron gates, walk across the courtyard to the gym entrance.

Prohibited Items: University High School, as with all campuses in Orange County Public Schools, is a smoke free campus. Smoking, use of electronic cigarettes, or use of any tobacco products are prohibited anywhere on campus. Other items not allowed at our athletic events include glass bottles, coolers, drinks without lids, alcoholic beverages, weapons, artificial noise makers, sticks, chains, illegal substances, laser pointers, fireworks, aerosol cans, pets, pepper spray, clothing with inappropriate language, or any other items deemed to be considered inappropriate by the school administration or Orange County Sheriff's Office.

Sportsmanship: Demonstration of proper sportsmanship is an expectation of all participating in an athletic event at University High School. Please refrain from any inappropriate behavior or language that could be considered as offensive to fellow spectators, officials, coaches, student-athletes, or school staff. Anything deemed as inappropriate could result in immediate dismissal from the event. Respect the game and the participants of the game.

Inclement Weather: University High School utilizes the Telvent Weather Sentry Sports Monitoring systems for dangerous weather at all outdoor athletic events. Our administrators, athletic trainers, and coaches all have access to and will receive warnings of incoming lightning. When the warning comes that lightning is within an 8 mile radius of the event, the contest will be suspended immediately. All student-athletes, staff, and spectators must relocate to a safe location. The public address announcer will give instructions to evacuate the playing area and spectators should go to their personal vehicle or to another designated area to remain until the warning is lifted. Student-athletes will report to their designated area for shelter. The OCPS 30-30 rule will be followed to determine when it is safe to resume the contest.

Directions

Address: 2450 Cougar Way; Orlando, FL 32817

From the North: Head south on 417 and exit at University Blvd. Go east on University Blvd to Rouse Road. Turn right to head south on Rouse Road to Eastwood Dr. Turn left on Eastwood and the school will be on the left hand side. The main entrance is at the end of the road.

From the South: Head north on 417 and then east on 408. Exit the 408 at Rouse Road and turn left to go north. Cross over Colonial Dr. Turn right at the next light, which is Eastwood Dr. The school will be on the left hand side. The main entrance is at the end of the road.

Via the 408: Exit at Rouse Road and turn left to go north. Cross over Colonial Dr. Turn right at the next light, which is Eastwood Dr. The school will be on the left hand side. The main entrance is at the end of the road.

Via the 528: Exit at 417 and head north to 408 and head east. Exit the 408 at Rouse Road and turn left to go north. Cross over Colonial Dr. Turn right at the next light, which is Eastwood Dr. The school will be on the left hand side. The main entrance is at the end of the road.

For events in the gym or weight room, please use the main entrance and park in the administration parking lot.

For outdoor events, please use the stadium entrance and park in that lot.

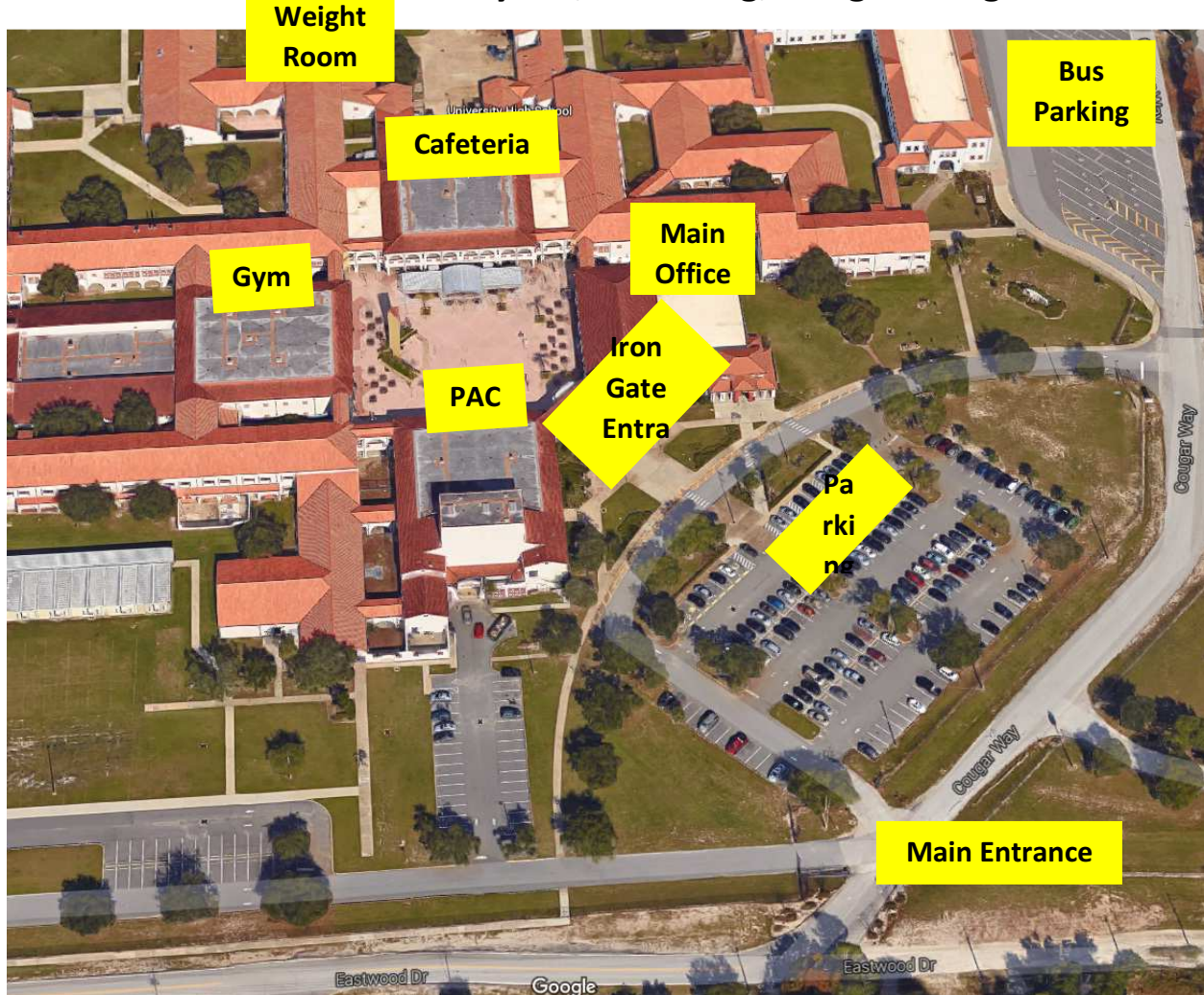

For all athletic events in the gym or the weightroom please use the main entrance to campus. Buses can drive through the loop in front of the iron gates to drop off and then park in the bus look. Spectators need to park in the main office parking lot. Enter through the iron gates and the gym entrance is across the courtyard (behind the bell tower). To get to the weight room, head towards the corner of the courtyard between the gym and cafeteria to then go down the hall next to the cafeteria. The weightroom is at the end of that hallway.

If necessary, overflow parking for the gym is located behind the PAC as well as in the stadium parking lot.
