Player fees:

Player fees are \$125.00/player this season & due by January 18th. Players will receive the following school issued equipment:

1. one home jersey
2. one away jersey
3. 1 pair of shorts

Upon the conclusion of try-outs players/parents will receive an emailed website and code to order your player package, which include required items (socks and practice jerseys) as well as additional optional items. This online store will be open for a limited time from Jan 9th-19th. These items will be shipped to the High School coaches and issued to players once fees are paid in full. Players will return jerseys and shorts at the end of the season; socks and practice jerseys are yours to keep. *Fees also cover referees, banquets, field rentals, transportation to and from all away games, equipment, etc.*

Games:

This season we have total of 15 games for the girls and 16 games for the boys. Boys will play Riverside Military School. They do not have a girls' team and that's the reason for the extra game.

Physicals:

They are required **BEFORE** you can try out; ***NO EXCEPTIONS***. Physicals need to be on file before or handed in on the 1st day of tryouts. Without it, you will NOT be allowed to try out until received.

School Rules:

All school rules apply to all players. They must be passing their core classes and keep in check appreciate behavior at all times. The disregard of these rules could result in sitting out half a game, suspension of a game, or being cut from the team completely with no refunds. Decisions are at the discretion of the coach.



Playing Time:

Being a school sport, there is no required playing time for players. Playing time is strictly at the discretion of the coaches and are based on ability, attitude, and effort.

Coaches:

The coaches are volunteers based on their knowledge, experience, ability and interest. They are here to help develop each player for the high school level of competition. If you need to speak with a coach, please allow 24hrs. before speaking with an assistant coach who will then relay your concern to the head coach who will then reach out to you, the parent/guardian. You may also email the coaches, but please allow a 24hr. cool down period before sending it.

Providing Transportation:

Will be provided bus transportation to all away games and back to school after the game, for player pick up. Parents may take home their player immediately following all away games, but have to be signed out. Players returning to the school need to be picked up within a timely manner. Coaches will stay with any player who has not been picked up but please be respectful of their time.

Admission to games:

Each school will most likely charge a gate fee of \$5/student or adult & \$3/child.

Fundraiser:

We will be holding a raffle November 4th-December 6th, drawing held soon after. Each returning player will receive 35 tickets to sell, if you sell all 35 and need additional let us know. New players trying out wanting to sell raffle tickets please see a coach ASAP. Prizes GRAND PRIZE: 1 LARGE Big Green Egg (\$1,100 value, shipped to winner if not local) and 3rd winner will *receive a \$100 Visa gift card.

Game Day Meals:

We would like to provide a healthy meal to all players before the beginning of each home game. We are working with places in the area like Subway, Chick-fil-a, Beef O' Brady's, etc. to provide a \$5 meal kit for all players on the day of the game. We will ask for those meals to be pre-paid along with your dues. This will ensure that your player has a healthy, semi-filling meal before all home games & if possible, away too. Each player will also be asked to donate a case of water for to all players throughout the season and along with their meals.
