The coaching staff will assist as directed by Rec Center Staff

The Coaching staff will contact the AD and Parents or Guardian or any swimmer or swimmer's that needed attention.

Emergency Action Plan for Island Rec Pool

One Guard on Duty

- Recognize Emergency
- 2 whistle blast to alert swimmers
- Perform rescue
- Asses the victim
- Send on looker to call 911 – if no on looker call 911 (if needed)
- Treat victim as needed
- Fill out accident report and notify Aquatics Director

Two or More Guards on Duty

- Guard A (first responder) recognize emergency
- 2 whistle blast to alert other lifeguard(s) to clear the water
- Guard A perform rescue
- Asses the victim
- Guard B call 911 (if needed)
- Guard A treat the victim as needed

- Guard B assist Guard A with treatment or perform crowd control
- All guards involved fill out accident reports and notify Aquatic Director

A.E.D

- The A.E.D. is located in Guardroom on the wall.

- First Aid Kit is located in Guardroom on the wall.
