The New Palestine Dragons are playing for a chance at hardware Friday night, then head to college on Saturday.

Friday's game against Pendleton Heights will determine at least a share of the Hoosier Heritage Conference title. It's the second straight year the Dragons and Arabians have met with a title on the line. NP is seeking its first HHC title since 1994 – when head coach **Sarah Gizzi** was the Dragons' leading scorer as a senior. NP has won eight conference titles in its history – four in the Big Blue River, three in the Rangeline and one in the HHC.

On Saturday, the Dragons will head to IUPUI's homecourt - the Indiana Farmers Coliseum – to face Triton Central. It will be the first game NP has played at a college venue since the 1990-91 season, when NP and TC met at Hinkle Fieldhouse. TC won that matchup 55-42.

The Dragons enter the weekend looking to bounce back from a 52-46 loss to Indian Creek. **Leah Seib** had 12 points and nine boards for the Dragons. **Katie Herron** tallied 11 points and eight boards, while **Haley Harrison** also scored 11 points.

Seib leads the Dragons with a 13.6 points per game and 6.6 rebounds per average, while **Megan Jolly** tallies 11.0 points and 3.1 assists per contest.

NP had won two straight entering the Indian Creek game, including a 67-14 victory over Herron last Tuesday. The Dragons' season began with a nine-game winning streak – the longest such streak to start a season in school history.

## Weekend foes

Pendleton Heights has been surging, having recently gone 2-1 at the Madison County Tournament. The Arabians' balanced attack is led by Lauren Landes, who averages 9.8 ppg and 2.6 apg. Laikyn Conner (6.1) and Aubree Dwiggins (6.0) are two of the HHC's top rebounders.

Triton Central is 16-1 and ranked No. 5 in the ICGSA 2A poll. Freshman Tenleigh Phelps leads TC with a 17.2 ppg average.

## Looking ahead

After this week, the Dragons have just four games remaining on the schedule – three of which will be at home. Next week, NP will host a surging Beech Grove squad Tuesday before facing Scecina Thursday.

## Winning mark

New Palestine has clinched its third consecutive winning season, after going 17-7 and 16-7 the last two years. The last time NP had three straight winning seasons was 1998-99, when the Dragons finished their eighth straight above-.500 campaign.

## HHC leaders

As of the most recent weekly conference update, the Dragons have several players among the HHC leaders. Forward **Leah Seib** is third in the conference in scoring (13.6) and leads the conference in rebounding (6.6). She is third in field goal shooting (.493) and leads the league in free throw shooting (.869). **Megan Jolly** is fifth in scoring, second in assists (3.1) and fourth in steals (2.5). **Haley Harrison** is third (.362) and **Emma Grable** fifth (.333) in 3-point shooting.

## Player of the Week

Guard **Megan Jolly** was named HHC Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 20-25 after her 17-point performance in the victory over Perry Meridian.

She led the Dragons to two sectional titles and three conference titles during her four-year tenure as player for coach Allen Cooper, now Dragons' athletic director. She played collegiately at LaSalle University in Philadelphia. After returning to New Palestine, she has coached with the Dragon program as a varsity assistant and as a middle school coach. Basketball is in her family – her father Bruce Haynes was the Dragons' varsity boys coach from 1990-95, and is currently a varsity assistant with the Dragons girls program. Her brother Noah Haynes spent a handful of seasons as the varsity boys coach at Brebeuf Jesuit. She lives in New Palestine with her husband Mike and their three children.
