Responsibilities

- Student Mentoring: spiritual development and athletic skill development
- Conduct organized, structured practices
- Program Organization: roster, uniform and equipment inventory, organize practice instruction, supervision of athletes, etc.
- Coaching Administration: pre- and post-season meetings with the Director of Athletics, parent meeting, CPR certified, etc.

Minimum Qualifications

- High School diploma
- Track & Field Coaching experience
- Must be organized and able to work independently with a professional attention to detail.
- Support the mission, philosophy, statement of faith, and core values of Oakland Christian School.
- Give testimony regarding your faith in Jesus Christ and be an active member of a Christian bible-based local Church.
