



## Copley High School Athletic Department

### Scout/Team Personnel Admission Policy

- Any person requesting to be admitted free of charge to a Copley High School athletic event for scouting purposes, must be on the pass list submitted to the athletic department, no later than 3:00pm on the day of the contest.
- Scouts will only be added to the pass list for any Copley High School home athletic event by calling and/or emailing their request to the Copley High School athletic department.
- A scout should not assume their name has been added to the pass list unless they receive confirmation from the athletic director or the athletic secretary. A coach cannot issue confirmation.
- Any person presenting themselves at the ticket gate as a 'scout and/or team personnel' will not be provided free admission, unless their name is on the pass list - **no exceptions.**
- The personnel working the ticket gate will issue receipts to any scouts that pay full price admission, so they can be reimbursed by their home school or athletic department.
- The only pass that will be honored for scouting purposes is a Suburban League pass. No other league pass will be honored for free admission.
- Any team personnel that does not arrive with the visiting team, on the team provided transportation must also be on the pass list.
- Copley High School reserves the right to refuse admission to any patron that is suspected to be under the influence of drugs, alcohol or any other inappropriate substance.
- This policy pertains to all scouts- high school, college, or professional. We understand the importance and value of scouting and will accommodate all requests that follow these procedures. This policy is simply to protect the integrity of the admission process to Copley High School athletic events.
