Dear Arabians:

The summer days are quickly passing by and we are already gearing up for another great school year of athletics in 2019-2020. This letter is to notify you that the ticket office is now open and 2019-2020 tickets can be ordered. We hope to see you at as many athletic contest as possible starting this August. After researching how to better serve our community and our student-athletes, we have found that a few changes were needed to stay competitive with other schools our size. As always, change brings an adjustment period. We will be available to help with this process. Below you will find additional information as well as the new changes for the next school year.

***PHHS Students Free*** – We are excited to announce that all high school students with a valid school ID will be permitted to enter all high school athletic events for free. Please take this into consideration when ordering your tickets. This does not apply to elementary and middle school contests.

***Price Increase*** – As stated above, research was done to make sure we were staying competitive with ticket pricing. We found a necessity to raise prices for Family All-Sports (\$220) and Adult All-Sports (\$80). Student All-Sports (K-8) and Senior Citizen (55+) will remain the same as previous years. Additionally, high school students will be admitted for free with their valid school ID.

***Football Seating*** – Reserved seating will only be permitted on the day of Homecoming from 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Reserving seats at other home football games will not be permitted. Please be courteous to your fellow fans in terms of the amount of seats you reserve and seats already reserved by others.

***Basketball Season Tickets*** – Due to the low amount of Basketball Season Passes previously sold, these passes are no longer available for purchase.

***Basketball Reserved Seats*** – Starting in 2019-2020 gym seating will be general admission. Due to the low amount of seat requests and wanting complete Title IX compliance, reserved gym seats will no longer be offered for boys' basketball games. At this time the visitor, student, and band sections will remain in the same areas.
