- ▶ IHSAA Pre-participation physical form must be on file in AD office.
- ▶ Physical forms can be found at phsathletics.com, ih saa.org, or at your doctor visit.
- ▶ The physical must be after April 1st of the previous school year to be valid (after April 1, 2019)

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must have pre-participation physical on file in AD office.
2. Must have all forms electronically signed in Final Forms.
3. Must have an IHSAA Athletic Transfer filed with IHSAA if changing schools.
4. Must pass 5 classes at the grade certification dates.

In Season Leagues

- ▶ An athlete may not participate in another league of the same sport when in season.
- ▶ Example would be travel baseball during high school baseball season.
- ▶ IHSAA will rule the athlete ineligible immediately.
