



**2019 IHSAA Unified Track & Field Sectional
Bloomington High School North
Saturday, May 18th at 1:00pm**



Welcome: Bloomington High School North would like to extend a warm welcome to all participants of the IHSAA Unified Track and Field Sectional at Dennis O. Martin Field and Ralph Sieboldt Track.

Participating Schools: Bedford North Lawrence, Bloomington North, Bloomington South, Center Grove, Columbus East, Columbus North, Edgewood, Franklin Community, Indian Creek, Terre Haute North, and Terre Haute South.

Entry Information:

1. Member schools retain the ability to change their entry list at any time prior to the deadline by re-entering www.myihxaa.net on the appropriate sport tab and modifying their entry as prescribed in the instructions. Changes prior to the deadline shall NOT be accepted by telephone.
2. Changes After Deadline
 - a. Accepted with \$100.00 prior to end of seeding, if reported to IHSAA Executive Staff member.
 - b. Accepted with \$200.00 after the end of seeding and prior to Friday, May 17, 2019 at 11:59 p.m.

Entries/Seeding

1. Coaches have until Thursday, May 16, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. to scratch participants and replace them with alternates listed on the Sectional entry roster.
2. At the Sectional meet, a scratch meeting must be held at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the first field event.
3. At the scratch meeting, coaches declare any scratches. There are no replacements at this meeting.
4. For the Girls 400m Relay and the Boys 400m Relay, coaches may scratch and replace the relay rosters up until the time the relay teams report to the clerk of the course, provide relay team members are entered as either a participant or an alternate.
5. A contestant whose relay team is scratched due to injury or disciplinary action against other relay team members shall not be scratched from other events if documented by a physician in the case of injury or by the principal in disciplinary action.
6. Heats and flights will NOT be reseeded following the scratch meeting.
6. The Meet Director will post a copy of the seeds to www.bloomingtonnorthathletics.com prior to noon, Friday, May 17th.

Advancement From Sectional to Regional:

1. Advancement will be by team. Individuals will not advance. Team advancement is determined by the top 3 team finishers at each sectional. The top 3 teams from each Sectional will advance to the Regional. Ties will be broken by the appropriate protocol.
2. Sectional - In the event of a tie for 3rd place (and qualifying for the Regionals), the tie will be broken by determining the greatest number of 1st place finishes in individual heats, inclusive of shot put and long jump. If a tie still exists, the tie will be broken by determining the greatest number of 2nd places finishes. The process will continue until the tie is broken.

3. If a tie still exists, a coin will be flipped to determine the team advancing to the next level of the tournament. In the event of a tie for a team championship, both teams will be recognized as winners, and duplicate awards will be provided for both teams.

Time Schedule (all times are approximate after the field events begin)

12:30 pm	Scratch meeting in Football Locker Room located at the South end of the track. All schools need a representative present.
1:00 pm	Field events (Long Jump and Shot Put) begin simultaneously
2:15 pm	National Anthem
2:20 pm	100 M Dash (Coed)
2:35 pm	400 M Dash (Coed)
2:55 pm	400 M Relay (Girls)
3:00 pm	400 M Relay (Boys)

Scoring:

1. Each final heat will carry the same weight for scoring (i.e., the winner of the fastest heat scores the same number of team points as the winner of the slowest heat).
2. All scoring will occur in final heats and flights are determined by the best certified times or distances.
3. All flights and heats will be seeded from best to worst.
4. The best times and distances will be assigned to the first heat or flight.
5. Participants from the same school may be assigned to the same heat.
6. Team points awarded for each final heat or flight will be the following:
 - A. 1st = 10, 2nd = 8, 3rd = 6, 4th = 5, 5th = 4, 6th = 3, 7th = 2, 8th = 1
7. The maximum number of participants in any heat or flight is 8.
8. No heat or flight will be run with less than 4 participants unless there are fewer than 4 participants entered.
9. Each heat or flight will have the same number of participants, except extra participants will be entered into the higher seeded heat(s) or flight(s).
Examples: 15 participants - 8 in the first heat and 7 in the second heat 17 participants - 6 in the first heat, 6 in the second heat, 5 in the third heat 23 participants - 8 in the first heat, 8 in the second heat, 7 in the third heat 19 participants - 7 in the first heat, 6 in the second heat, 6 in the third heat

Awards:

1. Trophy - to championship team
2. Ribbons - participation ribbons to participants

Team Entry/Package Pick-up:

Teams entrance is in the Southwest corner of the facility. (See Map #1) Package pick-up will be at this entrance. Principals, Athletic Directors and bus drivers should sign in at the spectator admissions gate.

Warm-Up Areas:

The infield will be used as a warm-up area for participants as well as a team area.

Team Area:

Coaches and teams are permitted in the infield.

Hospitality will be hosted in the tent located to the East of the football locker room.

Check- In:

Athletes in all running events should report to the clerk tent by second call. The clerk area will be located under the American flag at the 100 Meter Dash start area.

Equipment:

1. Eight Gill Fusion starting blocks will be provided by Bloomington North and these blocks will be used by all participants. Teams do not need to bring their own starting blocks to the meet.
2. Weight-in and measurement of shot will begin @ 12:45pm in maroon ticket shed adjacent to the shot put area.

Trainer:

The BHSN certified athletic trainer and staff will be available and will be located in the tent on the football field.


Results:

Parking:

Please note that the drive between the track facility and the school is a One-Way street. Busses and teams entering from Kinser Pike need to make a right turn at the school's main entrance (3-Way Stop) and proceed on Kinser to the next Left hand turn. You will see a sign directing you to BHSN Athletic Entrance. Please proceed up the drive, drop your athletes off at the gate, pass the field and park on the curve near the school.
