### **Student Screening for On-Site School and School Sponsored Extra-Curricular Activities**

Please assess your student daily before getting on a school bus or driving/walking to school or school sponsored extra-curricular activities for the following symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If your student has any of the symptoms above, please contact their medical provider and please contact the attendance line at your student's school.

Your student is excluded from on-site school and school sponsored extra-curricular activities until:

- They are symptom free and it has been 10 days from the onset of symptoms (unless otherwise specified in a statement with an alternative diagnosis from a medical provider, 24 hours fever free without fever reducing medication, and the provider believes that it is appropriate that the student return to on-site school and school sponsored extra-curricular activities sooner).
- Fever free (under 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit) for 3 consecutive days without the use of a fever reducing medication.

A statement from a medical provider stating that your student is released to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities is required before reporting to on-site school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.

Please encourage your student to notify their teacher/coach if they develop any of the above symptoms during the school day/activity.

Please see below for additional exclusionary criteria:

- Student has been diagnosed with COVID-19. They will be excluded for at least 10 days from the day symptoms began AND 72 hours fever free without fever reducing medications, and improvement of respiratory symptoms.
- If someone living in the home with your student has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the student will be excluded for 14 days after the last close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes) to the individual with COVID-19.
- If student has been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes) with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, the student will be excluded for 14 days after the close contact.

A statement from a medical provider is required stating that your student is released to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.
