Screening

- All MCCSC Staff and Contracted Staff will participate in a self-screening program before reporting to on-site work and/or school sponsored extra/co-curricular activities
- All MCCSC student participants and student athletes will participate in a self-screening program before reporting to on-site work and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities

Symptoms of COVID-19

- Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Exclusions for Symptoms

- Students/participants that exhibit COVID-19 symptoms will be excluded until:
 - They are symptom free and it has been 10 days from the onset of symptoms (unless otherwise specified in a statement with an alternative diagnosis from a medical provider, 24 hours fever free without fever reducing medication, and the provider believes that it is appropriate that the student/participant return to on-site school and school sponsored extra-curricular activities sooner).
 - Fever free (under 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit) for 3 consecutive days without fever reducing medication.
 - A statement from a medical provider is required stating that the student/participant is released to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.

Additional Exclusionary Criteria

Student/ participant has been diagnosed with COVID-19. They will be excluded for at least 10 days from the day symptoms began AND 72 hours fever free without fever reducing medications, and improvement of respiratory symptoms.

If someone living in the home with the student/participant has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the student/participant will be excluded for 14 days after the last close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes) to the individual with COVID-19.

If student/participant has been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes) with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, the student/ participant will be excluded for 14 days after the close contact.

A statement from a medical provider is required stating that the student/participant is released to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: If a student/participant has symptoms is the entire group excluded?

A: No, only the symptomatic individual is excluded pending medical diagnosis.

Q: If a student/participant is positive for COVID-19 is the entire group excluded?

A: Unfortunately, there is not a “one size fits all” answer to this. MCCSC will be guided by the local health department in group/facility closures and exclusions. Many factors play a role, most importantly who and how many were in close contact (within 6ft for 15 minutes) of the positive individual and what activity was the positive individual participating in (activity that produces high droplets).

Confidentiality and Contact Tracing

- All student/staff/contractor symptom and diagnosis status is **confidential** information.
- The Monroe County Health Department or the Indiana State Department of Health will conduct the contact tracing and notification of the individuals who need to be made aware.
- MCCSC may be called upon to help with reported symptoms, attendance, who the individual was in contact with and how long, and what activity they were participating in.

Essential Safe Guards

- Refer to guidance from the CDC, Indiana High School Athletic Association, Indiana Department of Education, Indiana State Department of Health, and the Monroe County Health Department for all safe guards
- Important to inform students/participants to stay home if they are not feeling well
- Self Screening
- Social Distancing
- Required facial coverings unless under going rigorous activity or it poses a health risk
- Hand Hygiene
- Attendance Tracking
- Abiding exclusion and closure recommendations

Activity Essentials

- Self Screen
- Social Distance
- Wash/Clean Hands
- Required facial coverings unless under going rigorous activity or poses a health risk.
- Before activity begins ask students/participants if they have COVID-19 symptoms.
 - *Let them know to come to you privately. If the answer is yes, the individual is immediately excluded. Report to Building Principal. Building Principal contacts Dr. Mobley.
- Take attendance
- Disinfect
