Webster Groves JV Girls Volleyball Tournament

Saturday, September 29, 2018
Webster Groves High School

Format: 2 pools of 4 teams, round-robin play.

- Each pool play match will consist of 2 sets to 19, no cap, win by 2.

1st place teams from each pool will play for championship.

2nd place teams from each pool will play for overall 3rd place.

- Final matches: games 1 and 2 to 25, no cap, win by 2. If game 3, 15 points, no cap, win by 2.

Tie Breakers to determine 1st place in pool.

- Head-to-head record.
- Head-to-head net points.
- Overall net points.
- Flip of Coin.

Tie Breaker to determine 2nd place in pool.

- One game playoff to 15 points, no cap, win by two.
- If 3 teams are tied for 2nd place, the above tie breakers will be use to determine which of the three teams is 1st place of the tied teams. The 2nd and 3rd tied teams will play one game to 15 points (no cap, win by 2) and their winner will then play the 1st tied team one game to 15 points (no cap, win by 2).

Schedule: Each pool plays the same schedule. (Times are approximate and may actually be earlier or later depending on previous match.)

2:00 Finals (championship on Ct. 1, 3rd place on Ct. 2)

Warm-up: Each team will be allowed 17 minutes of warm-up time before their first match of the day. There will only be a maximum of 10 minutes of warm-up time before all subsequent matches. Teams should be ready to take the court immediately upon the conclusion of the previous match. Balls for warm-ups will be provided.

Lockers: Locker room space will be limited. Teams will be able to use a locker room if needed, but will not be assigned a locker room for the day.

Admission: \$3 admission will be charged.

**Concessions/
Hospitality:** A concession stand will be open and a hospitality room will be provided for coaches and officials.

Expenses: Tournament expenses will be split among the participating schools.

Awards: 15 individual medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.

Officials: Game scorekeepers and officials will be provided. Each team will need to provide a libero tracker (if used) and a line judge for each of their matches.
