Evaluation Notes

- Location: Edgewood High School. Enter through door 4 on the east side of the building. Players need to register in the main gym. Tryouts will be held in the auxiliary gym.
- Players need to arrive at least 15 minutes before the tryout begins to register for the tryout. On the day of the tryout, each player must have a signed medical release form. Register online at <https://forms.gle/dzG1YeNgud1urvAUA> or bring in the form at the bottom of this page.
- The gym will be closed to everyone but the evaluators and the players trying out. Parent seating will be available in the main gym.
- There is no charge to participate in the evaluations.
- Dress in basketball attire. Bring clean shoes for the gym floor. Please do not bring your own basketball.

The Edgewood Boys Travel Basketball consists of the following:

- The fee for travel basketball will be between \$175-200. This fee will cover MYT's Winter League at Franklin Community High School (Jan. 11-Feb. 15), team insurance, game uniform, and shooting shirt. Final cost will depend on the cost of uniforms and shooting shirts.
- 1-2 teams per grade level. 8 players per team. 1 head coach and 1 assistant coach per grade level. We strive to make travel basketball available to as many players as possible. In order to have accomplish this goal we need volunteer coaches. If we have enough interest, we will need coaches for a 2nd team in each grade level.
- Teams will practice 1-2 times a week. Each practice will last between 75-90 minutes. Each team will have three 1 ½ hour practices. All teams will practice on Monday and Wednesday. A third practice is being added this year on Tuesday or Thursday. Practice locations include our elementary and high school gyms.
- Parents must provide transportation to practice and games.
- Participation in the RBBYS basketball league is optional.
- The Midwest Youth Tournament's league at Franklin consists of 12 games. Games will be played on Saturdays.
- The decision to participate in other shootouts and tournaments will be left up to each team's coach and parents.
