PARMA HEIGHTS, OH—The Green Wave of Holy Name looks to retain a share of the top spot in the Great Lakes Conference this evening as they host the Parma Redmen in OHSAA Week 5 action.

The Green Wave improved their record to 2-0 in the GLC, and 3-1 overall, with a 43-21 win over Rocky River last Friday. Senior **RB Robert Sherrod** led the way as the Namers accumulated 374 yards on the ground as a team. Sherrod punished the Pirates by piling up 221 yards on 27 carries and scoring a pair of touchdowns. Sherrod's classmate, **RB Trevor Dotson**, was also a major contributor to the ground game with 13 carries for 59 yards and two touchdowns. Rocky River's running game, meanwhile, was held to 90 yards by the Green Wave defense. Total yards in the game were 494-272 in favor of Holy Name.

The win moved the Namers up into the all-important eighth spot in the Division III, Region 10 computer rankings—up from #11 last week. The top eight teams in the region qualify for the regional playoffs.

After managing just 12 points in a 14-12 loss to Padua Franciscan in Week 2, the Green Wave offense has surged to score 102 points over the last two games.

Senior **QB Nicholas Mercuri** has completed 15 of 24 passes (62.5%) for 178 yards and four touchdowns—without throwing an interception—over those two games.

He has been spreading the ball around to different receivers as well, making it difficult for opposing defenses to key on one key player to take out of the passing game.

On the season, Mercuri has only been picked off once in 69 pass attempts (1.4% of passes) while connecting for six touchdowns passes (8.7% of passes).

Holy Name will try to keep the offensive attack rolling tonight, through the air and on the ground, against a Parma team that has lost three games in a row while allowing 134 points in the process.

Holy Name defeated Parma, 42-14 in the final regular season game of the 2018 season—their fourth win in four years over the Redmen.

AROUND THE GREAT LAKES CONFERENCE—Holy Name and conference newcomer Buckeye are the only two remaining undefeated teams in Great Lakes Conference play but, with plenty of football left to play over an eight-game conference schedule, the GLC title is still very much up for grabs.

Bay posted a huge 22-19 win over Valley Forge last Friday in a tilt that pitted the 2018 conference co-champs against each other. The Rockets' comeback win puts both teams at 2-1 in the GLC along with Fairview. It also helped Bay ascend to the top of the Division III, Region 10 computer points.

The Namers will travel to Bay next week for a game that could be a pivotal match-up in the GLC title chase.
