PARMA HEIGHTS, OH—Holy Name and Rocky River square off this afternoon in a key early-season Great Lakes Conference battle. The Green Wave and Pirates have each won two of their first three games and have each picked up a win in conference play. Six of the nine teams in the GLC have already lost a game in league play in what is shaping up to be a wide-open race in the expanded nine-team circuit.

The Green Wave has now out-scored its opponents 109-14 through the first three weeks of the season, including 97-0 in their two shutout wins over Cleveland Central Catholic and Normandy.

The Namers blitzed the Invaders, 59-0, in their Home and Great Lakes Conference Opener last Thursday. Holy Name scored an amazing six touchdowns in the first quarter alone, staking themselves a 41-0 lead. The scoring and yardage was spread around quite a bit with senior **RB Robert Sherrod** the only player to score twice in the game with a pair of rushing touchdowns.

Senior **QB Nick Mercuri** only put the ball in the air seven times, completing four passes—three of them for touchdowns to three different receivers.

With the game being played on Thursday, the Green Wave and Invaders avoided the severe weather that wreaked havoc with games around Northeast Ohio last Friday.

Not only is this a big early-season game in the Great Lakes Conference, it has major implications as these two teams jostle for position in the Division III, Region 10 rankings (see bottom of page 3). Both teams are just outside the top eight teams which is the cut-off to qualify for the OHSAA post-season.

The winner of this game stands a good shot of getting inside the Top Eight while the loser will certainly be on the outside looking in going into Week 5.

Holy Name is looking to snap a three-game losing skid to the Pirates. Rocky River narrowly won last year's meeting between these two schools, 16-14, helping it sneak into the playoffs as the #8 seed.

The last Holy Name win over Rocky River was a 14-10 Namers victory in the final regular season game of the 2015 season. It was the sixth win in a thrilling run of seven in a row that included a 50-43 playoff win over Perry the following week.

AROUND THE GREAT LAKES CONFERENCE—Holy Name is one of only three teams to make it through Week 3 of the season without a loss in Great Lakes Conference play.

Going into last night's action, GLC newcomers Buckeye were tied with the Green Wave at 1-0 while the Valley Forge Patriots, who shared the GLC title with Bay last season, were the only 2-0 team.

The Patriots and Rockets went head-to-head in Bay last night while Buckeye hosted Elyria Catholic.
