

**Dear Volleyball Parents / Spectators;**

The following information pertains to home Volleyball competitions at Hamilton Heights. Due to construction at HHHS, all volleyball games are played at the Student Activity Center in Arcadia (formally the Middle School). The address is: 420 W. North Street, Arcadia, IN 46030.

Please park in the south lot (west lot is available for overflow parking) and enter the entrance on the south by the flag pole (Entrance B).

Games are played in the west gym.

Per IHSAA guidelines, seating is limited to a total of 250 spectators. This should not be an issue. Home fans will sit on the WEST side and opponents will sit on the EAST side.

Family members may sit together, but please remain at least 6 feet from other family units. Bleacher seats will not be marked where you may or may not sit. We feel that as adults, we are all capable of understanding what social distancing means.

Tickets are \$5.00 - cash only.

**We respectfully request that you wear a face covering** during the event at all times unless you are eating. Most importantly, if you have any signs or symptoms of Covid-19 listed below, we are asking you to **stay at home**.

Signs and Symptoms of Covid-19

- A fever of 100.4 ° F or greater
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

Concession stand will be open and serving pre-packaged items.

Restrooms will be available in the hallway east of the gymnasium but we highly encourage spectators to stagger their usage of the concession stand and restrooms. Waiting until the end of games or breaks in games when most people try to use these facilities, may create lengthy lines. Staggering usage can help avoid these situations and provide better social distancing.
