Are You Interested in Playing Golf for King HS for the 2019 Season?

BASIC INFORMATION FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

Physicals - All athletes must be cleared with an athletic physical before they are allowed to tryout. Athletes will need to go their provider or CVS to complete the physical. Check the King website for more information if needed.

Equipment - each golfer is expected to have their own bag of clubs, golf balls and tees. Equipment is not provided.

Spring Practice - contact with incoming 9th graders will begin May 1, 8, and 15 for golfers who have prior experience with lessons and/or 9 hole competition.

New golfers - a 4 day clinic* will be offered at General Old Golf Course during the first week of summer break, June 3-6, from 9-11:00AM. Professional golf instructor, Zach Ashman, will conduct the clinic. A maximum of 6 golfers may sign up for a \$60 cash fee payable at the golf shop. Call the pro shop at the course to reserve your spot.

Summer Practice - lessons/practices/competition will be on your own until we meet as a team the first week of August.

Expenses - General expenses are included in the spirit pack (team polo, towel, visor, green fees), approximately \$250 per player. Additional expenses vary from Varsity to JV that will include tournament fees, additional apparel etc.

6th Period PE Golf Athletic Class - the names of the top 10-12 golfers will be turned in to their perspective counselors; they will be added to PE Athletics Golf in the fall, under teacher of record, Boys' Coach LeDuc. All fall practices will start approximately 2:00PM. You will be released from school after your 5th period class.

*If you attend the clinic, this does not guarantee a spot in the class. You will still need to compete for the top 10-12 spots to get in. If you don't make the class, you may try out again the following year.

Suggestions - Lessons and organized competitive play are highly encouraged to prepare you to make the team and enjoy the high school golf experience. It's never too late to learn, but if you are just learning, you will need a lot of help from your support group to help you reach the minimum scores needed to compete.
