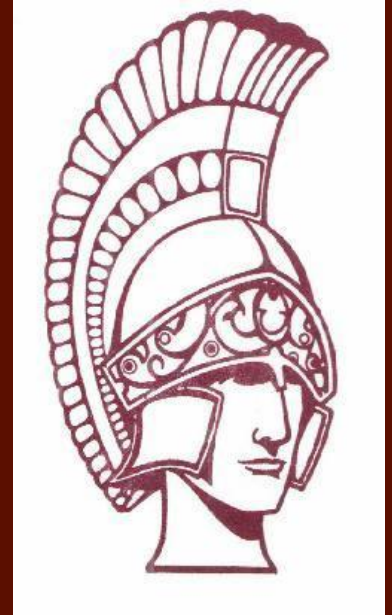

# POINTS OF EMPHASIS

Social Media (profanity; harassment, etc) -- BE SMART.

Behavior in the community -- Keep in mind our athletes are role models and known in the community. Your actions are being watched and emulated.

Being present for violations (vandalism, parties, etc) -- You may not have physically taken part in the action, but if you are present, you may still be in violation.

# PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

1. Substance use:

Alcohol, tobacco, nicotine, vaping, nicotine-delivery systems, illegal drugs, prescription medications not prescribed to the athlete, paraphernalia associated with any of the substances, counterfeit substances represented as prohibited substances.

# PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

## 2. Hazing

Coercing another student, including the victim, to perform some act of initiation to another student or organization; permission, consent, or assumption of risk by the victim does not lessen this prohibition.



# PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

3. Violation of law and/or violation of school Student Code of Conduct

# PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

4. All other acts unbecoming of a Spartan student-athlete as determined by the administration. Acts or gestures which would be considered “unbecoming” are those that are rude, obscene, dangerous, immoral and/or in any way reflect poorly on Boardman Local Schools.

Monitor academics

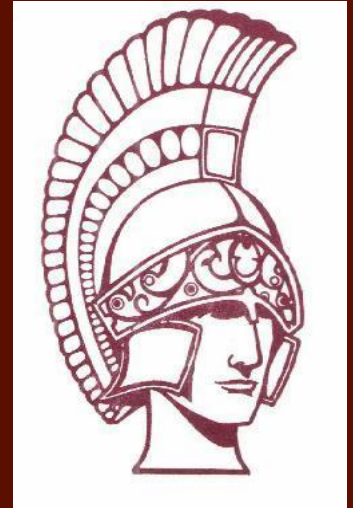
# FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS/EQUIPMENT
