Parent/Player Covenant

The parents, players, and spectators should never yell at each other. If you see any acts of hostility please notify your Recreation Director immediately.

5. Spectators' Role

The parents, players and spectators should cheer for their team and that is all. They should avoid officiating for the officials and coaching for the coaches. They should be a positive influence on their team.

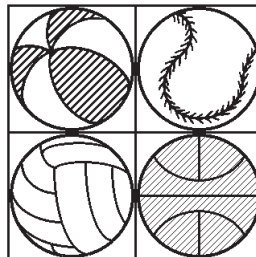
