- April 6 (Thu) Jecheon. Visit village, monorail or boat ride. Drive to Gyeongju (overnight in Gyeongju).
- April 7 (Fri) UNESCO site visits to Gyeongju (overnight in Seoul). Bulguksa, Seokguram, Royal Tombs.
- April 8 (Sat) DMZ tour. Panmunjeom and Third Tunnel.
