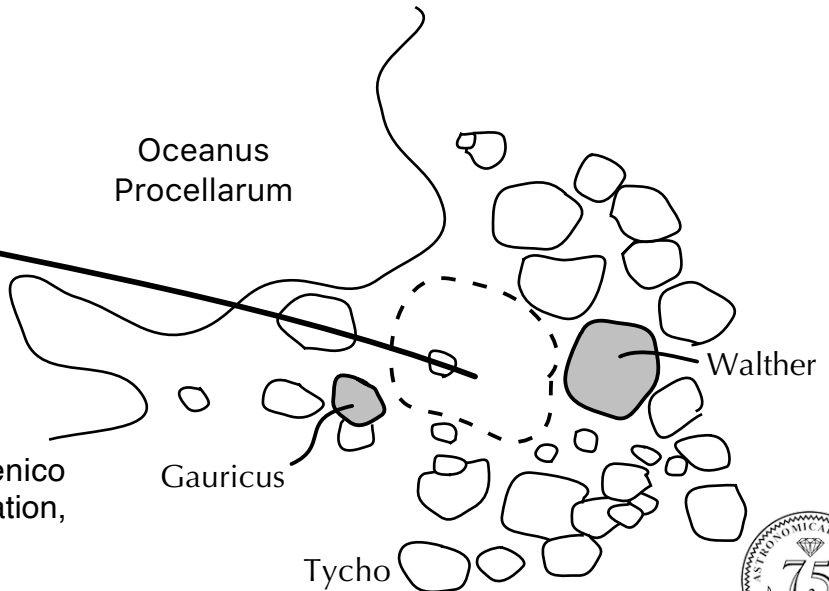
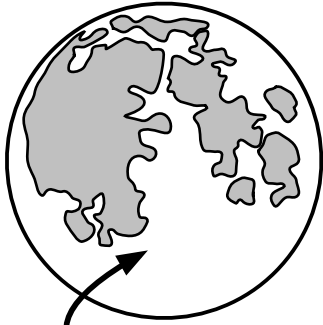

1. Between craters Walther and Gauricus



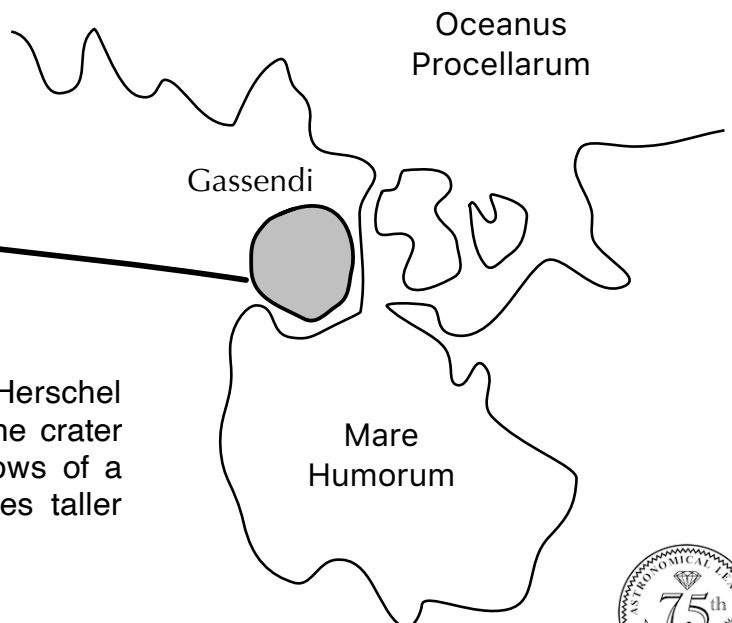
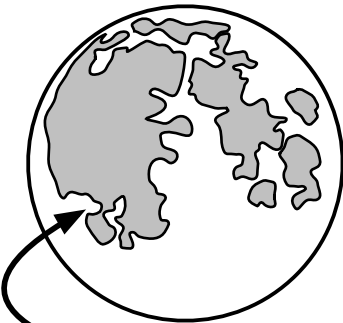
Best seen: April 3; April 21, 2021.

Best seen: April 5; and April 24, 2021.
